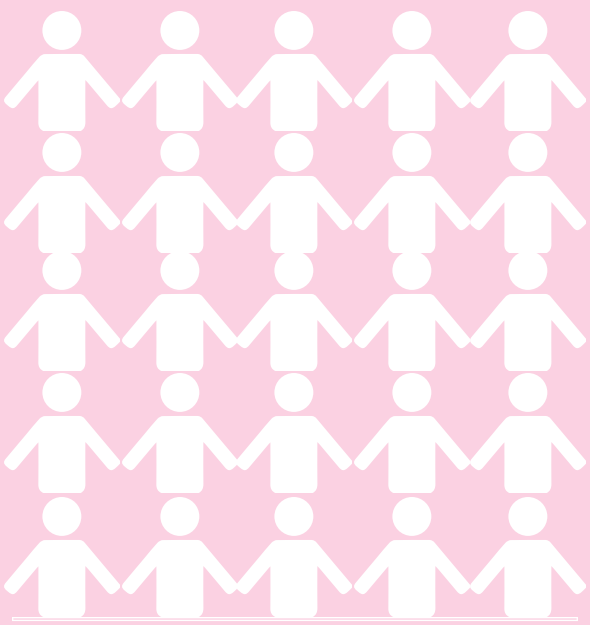
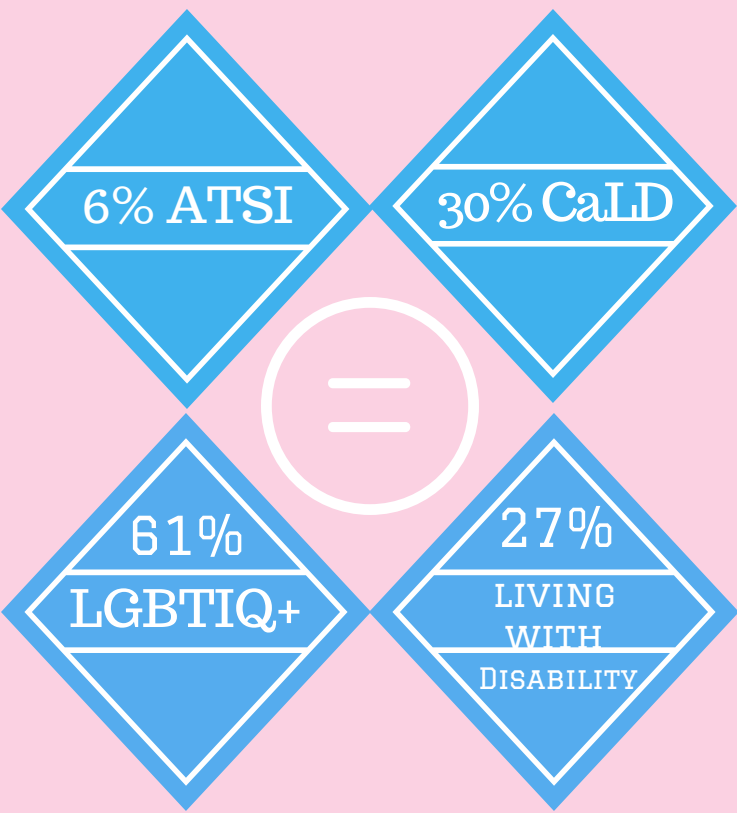


2017 YEP YOUTH SURVEY RESULTS

Majority still said they get their sex & SHBBV info from social media, Internet & Friends.




But in 2017, 48% said that they got their SHBBV info from their Doctor or GP!!!

52% thought that their knowledge of SHBBV knowledge increased in 2017

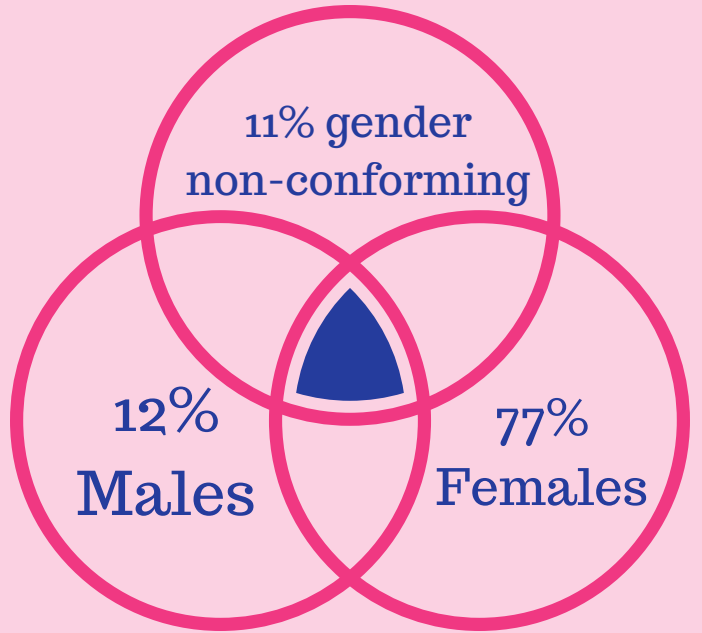


58% said that they did not have a positive sexual health education experience at school


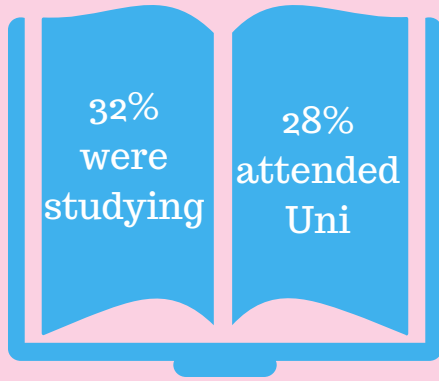
50% said that they can't discuss SHBBV, sexuality & sexual experiences with their parents





68% were between the ages of 18-25 Years




68% were working

15% went to a sexual health clinic in the last year 85% did not




31% had an STIBBV check in the last year 69% did not




53% who had an STIBBV check said that their experience was positive
