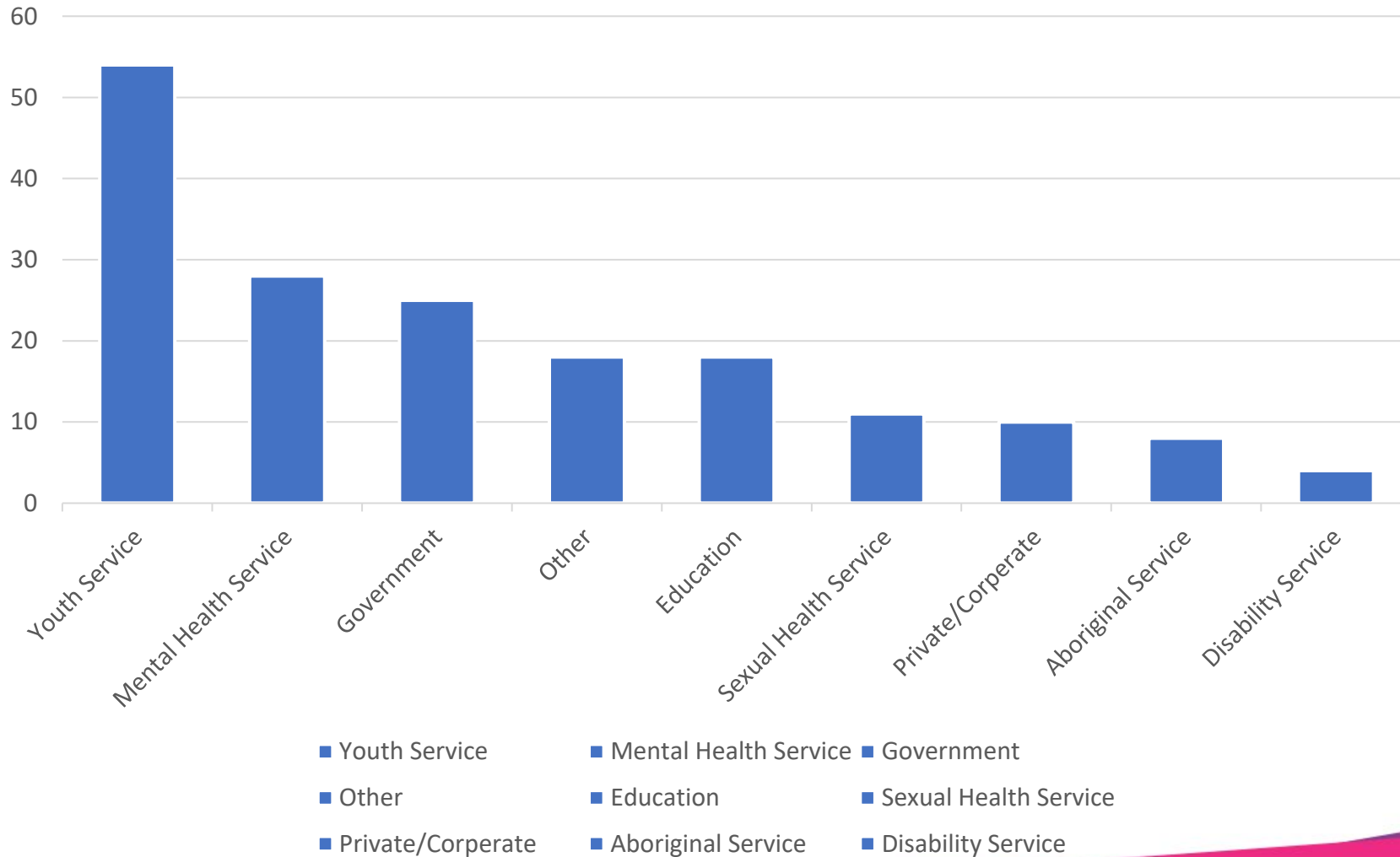

Number of Responses by Organization



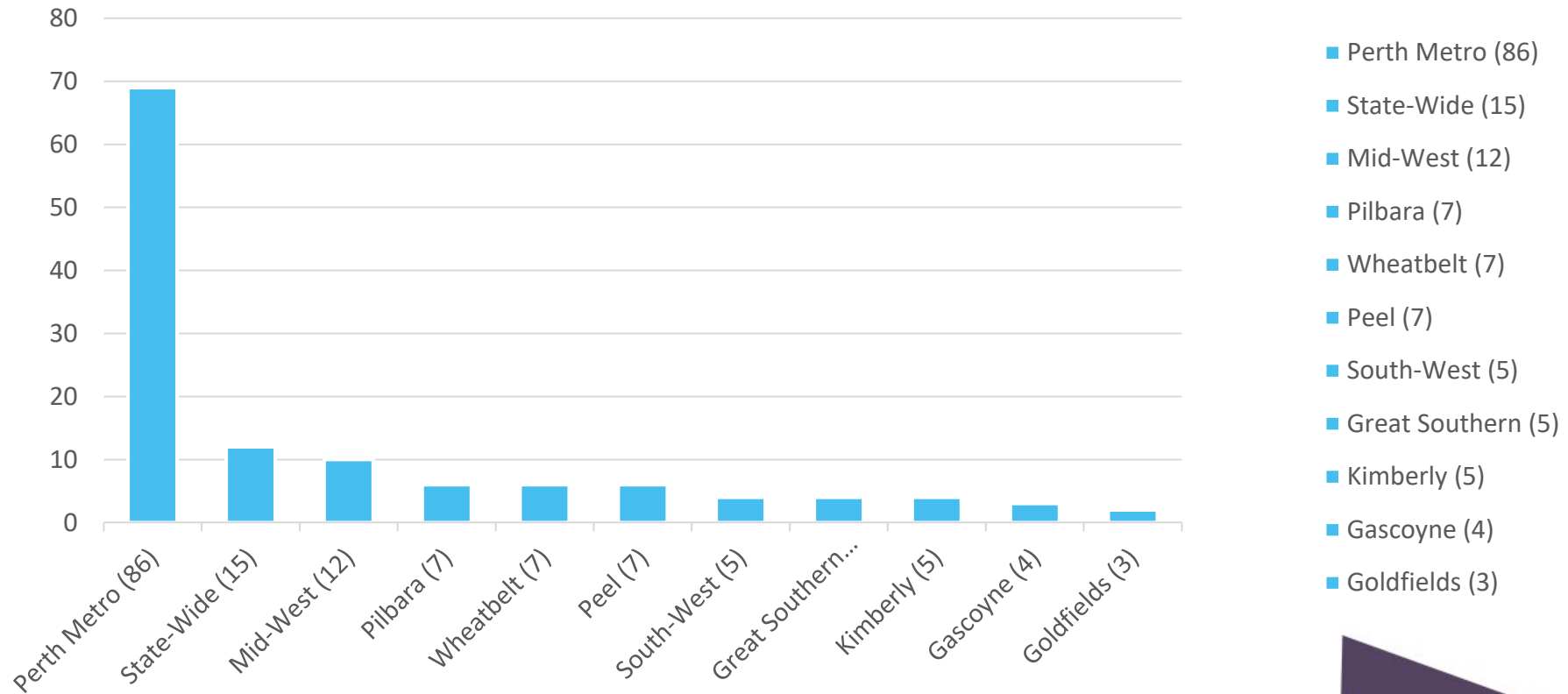

What Regions did services work in?



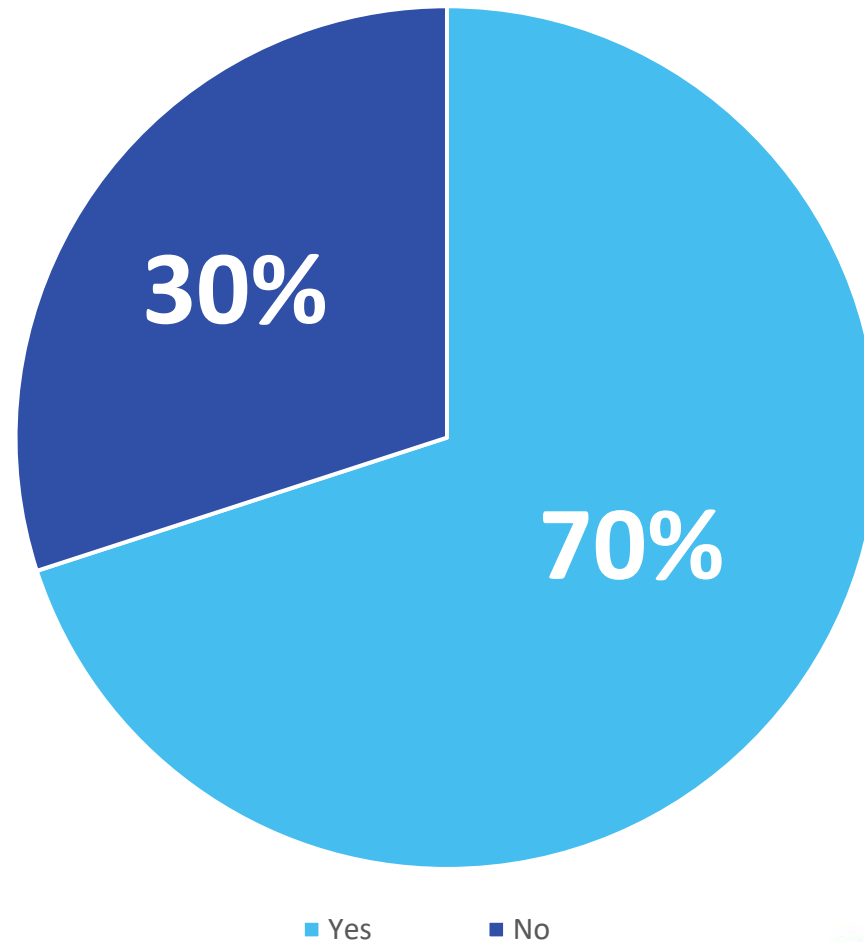

Have services had any interaction with YEP in 2020?



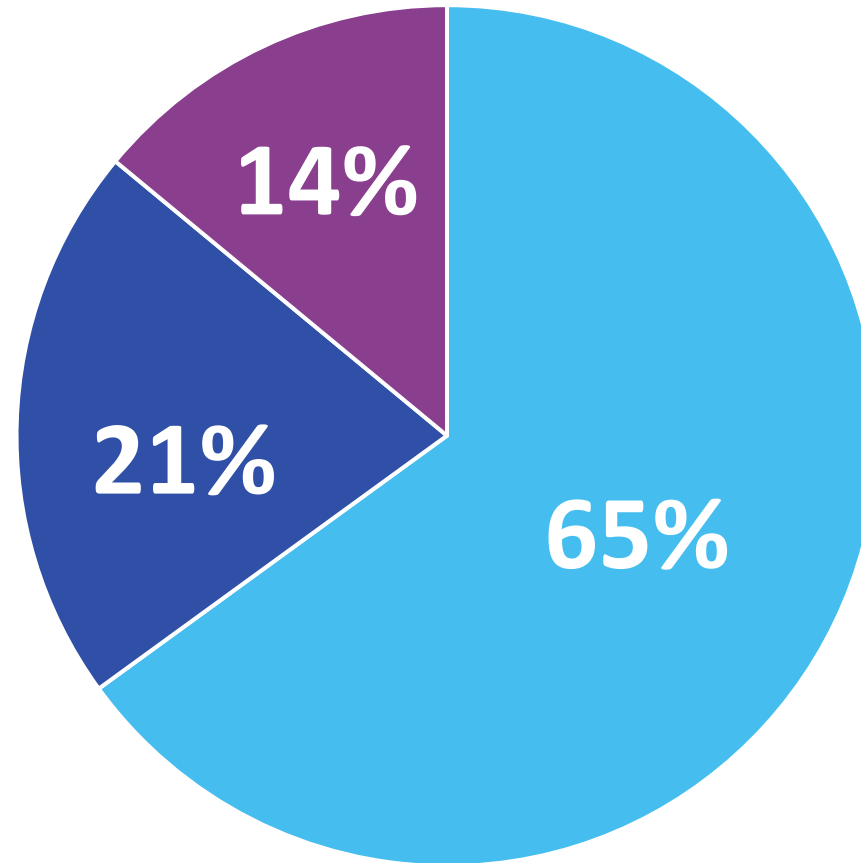
Have you had any interaction with YEP in 2020?

Some Choice Statistics



- **68%** of respondents believed YEP helped increase their knowledge, skills and confidence regarding sexual health
- **71%** feel there are more confident discussing sexual health issues with the young people they work with
- **59%** agree that YEP's online resources helped them connect with the young people they work with
- **62%** believe YEP's resources have assisted their collaborative practice

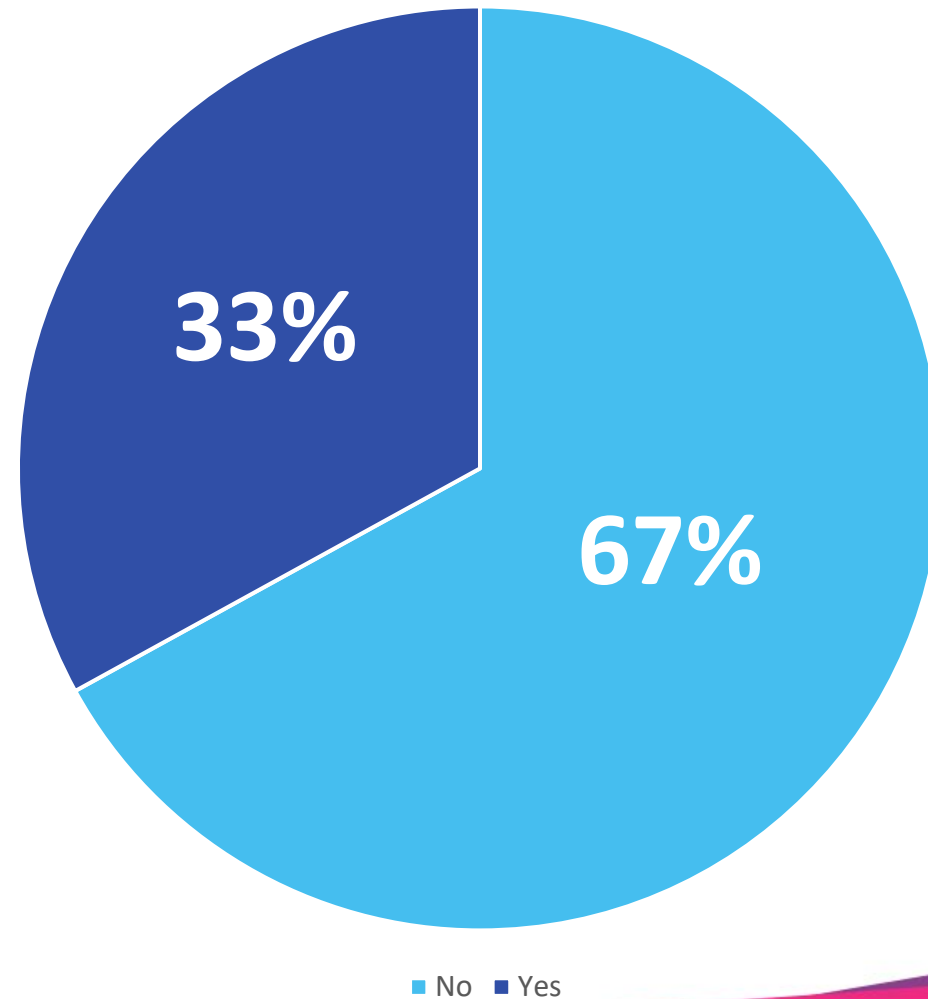

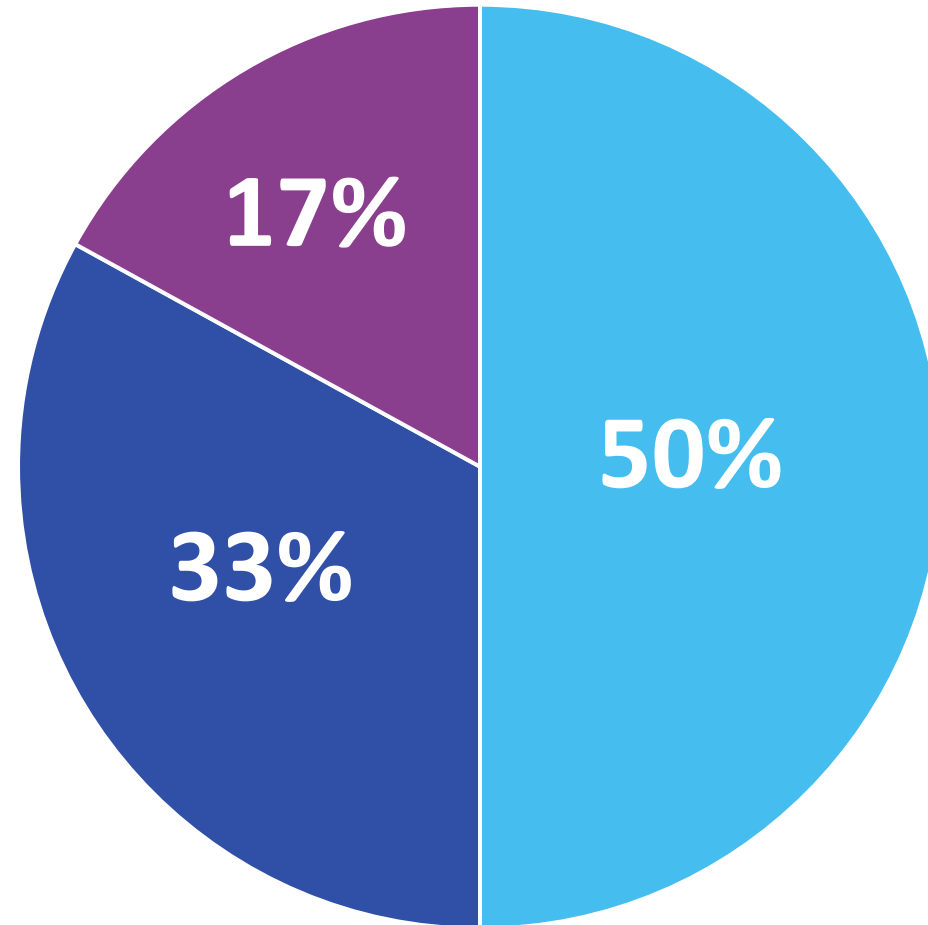
If you offer SHBBV services, do you think your organization has made your service more youth friendly in 2020?

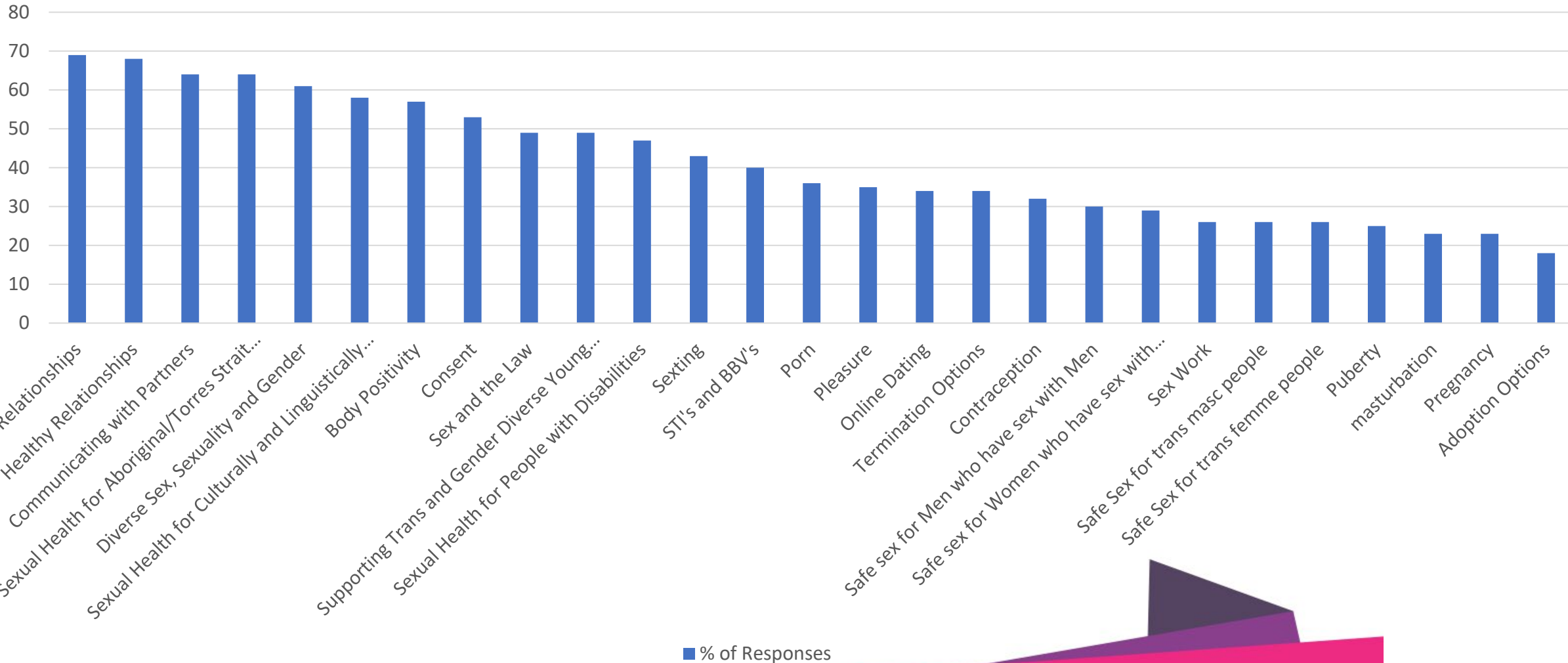

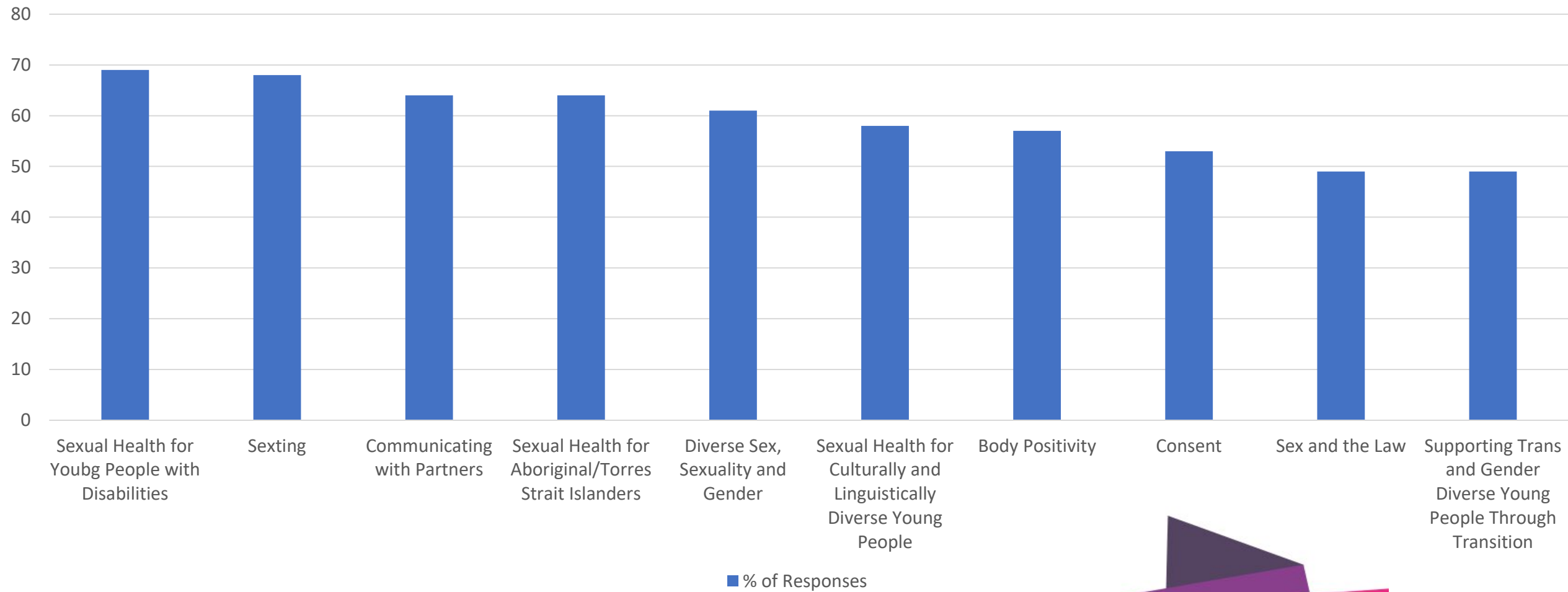

How can YEP help the youth sector support young people with sexual health issues?



“Continue to provide resources and the latest evidence based information as well as strategies to engage with you people”

“More accessibility of content to those without internet/phones”

“Support of further peer support programs, continued awareness around issues affecting survivors of sexual abuse/assault and appropriate referrals and resources. Continued community education in ways that meet the target community where they are.”

“Possible collaboration for sexual health groups at places like headspace for youths to access this info.”

“Continue to develop and evolve with young people to find out what platform best suits them to discuss issues that may be present to them. Using media such as tik tok to share vital information in a digestible format for young people and service providers to utilise”

“Increase regional education via webinar or in person.”
