Fetishisation is the act of making someone an object of sexual desire based on some aspect of their identity. It reduces someone to a single aspect of their identity, like their ethnicity or disability, and focusing on that aspect in a way that is often objectifying and dehumanizing. 👤 ⚠️

Fetishisation is problematic and can often disguise itself as flattery. It is important to remember that fetishisation is not just a preference or compliment. When someone is reduced to only their attributes such as their race or sexuality, it can tip over from being just a preference to being a fetish.

Porn can fetishise people in a range of different ways from the title, category or plot line. Titles such as “Lesbians Seduced by Right Guy” as well as categories such as MILF, Asian or Teen all fetishise and are common in mainstream porn videos.

Mainstream porns high views lead to increased social and mental consequences for fetishized individuals, including racism, ableism, sexism, and ageism. This can harm self-esteem and create challenges in dating and relationships. While some individuals can incorporate their sexual fetish without issues, others may experience negative impacts on intimacy and sex drive. 📱
