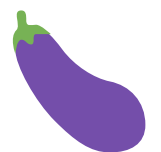


How to Use a Condom for Safer Sex



Reasons people use condoms

- Condoms help prevent sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and blood borne viruses (BBVs), unintended pregnancy, and infections such as bacterial vaginosis.
- Condoms can be used during vaginal sex, anal sex, and oral sex.
- Condoms can be used with sex toys such as dildos or vibrators.
- Condoms are affordable and accessible.
- Condoms put people at ease.

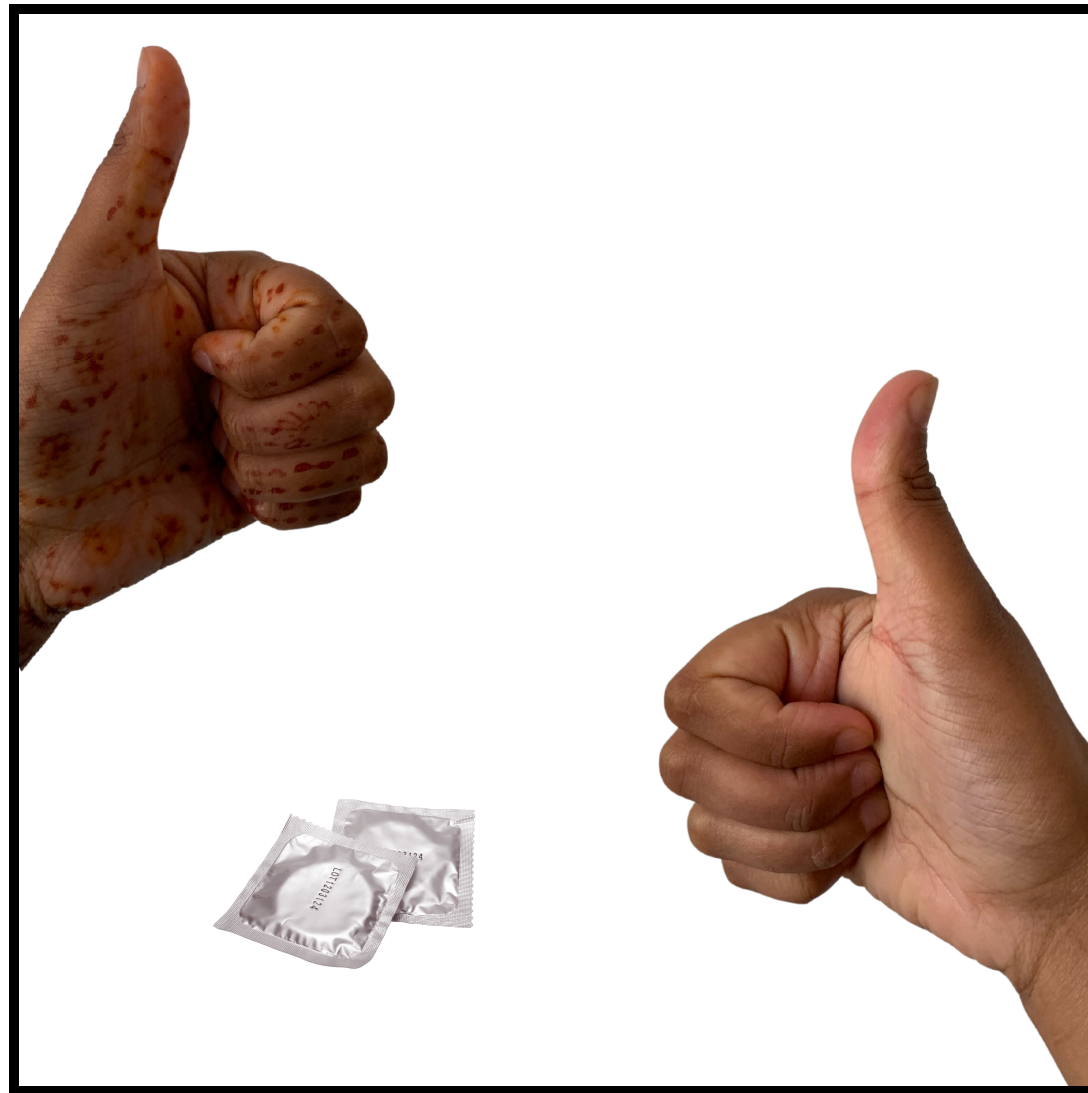
Note

Condoms are a single use item. Change your condom if:

- You put the condom on a penis the wrong way
- Are having sex with multiple people
- Are inserting the penis / toy into different body parts (vagina/anus/mouth)

How to use a condom

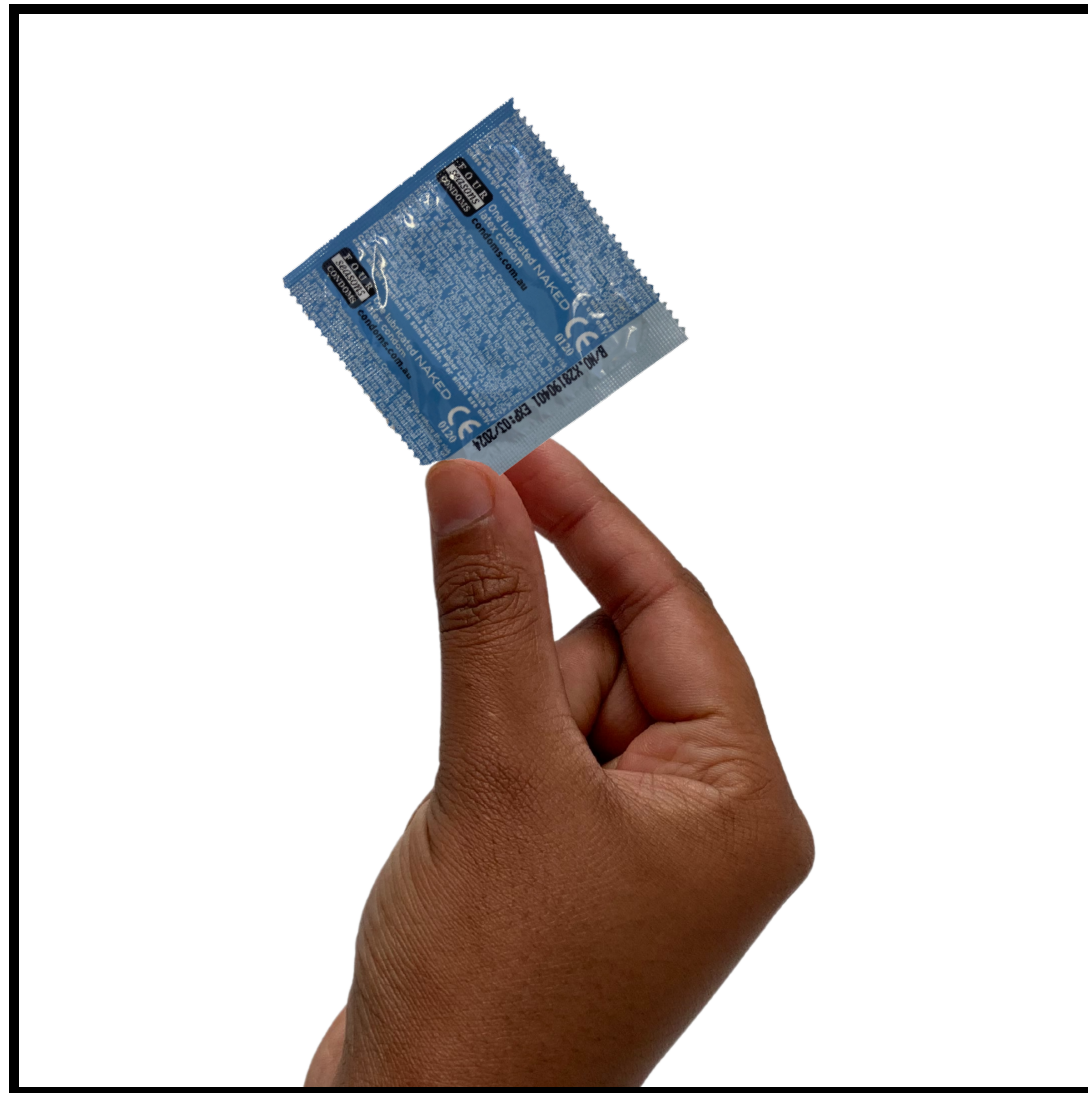
STEP 1



You and your partner both agree to have sex and use a condom.

How to use a condom

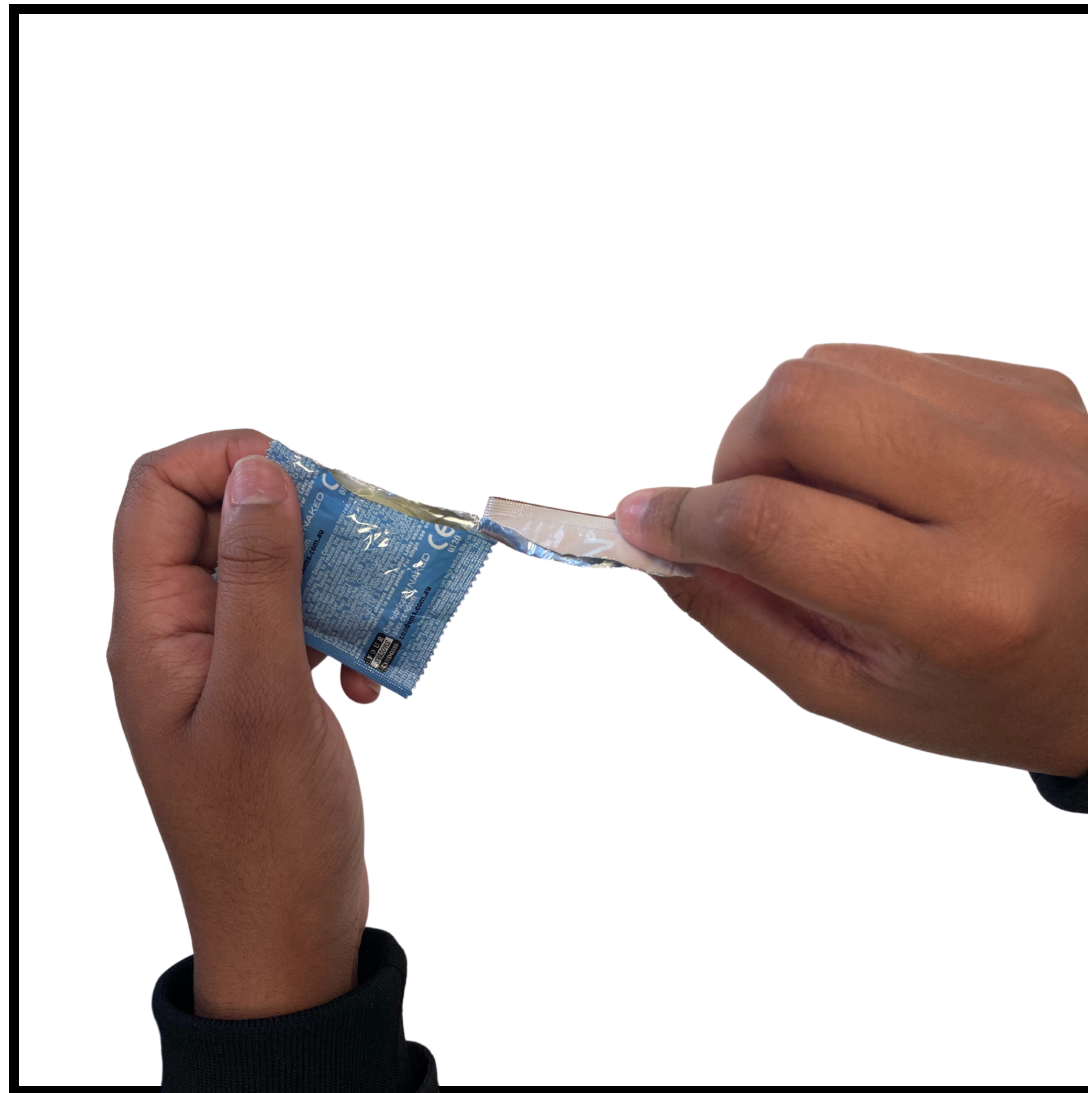
STEP 2



Get a condom.
Check the expiry date.
Check the packet is sealed and undamaged.

How to use a condom

STEP 3



Carefully tear open the packet with your hands.

How to use a condom

STEP 4

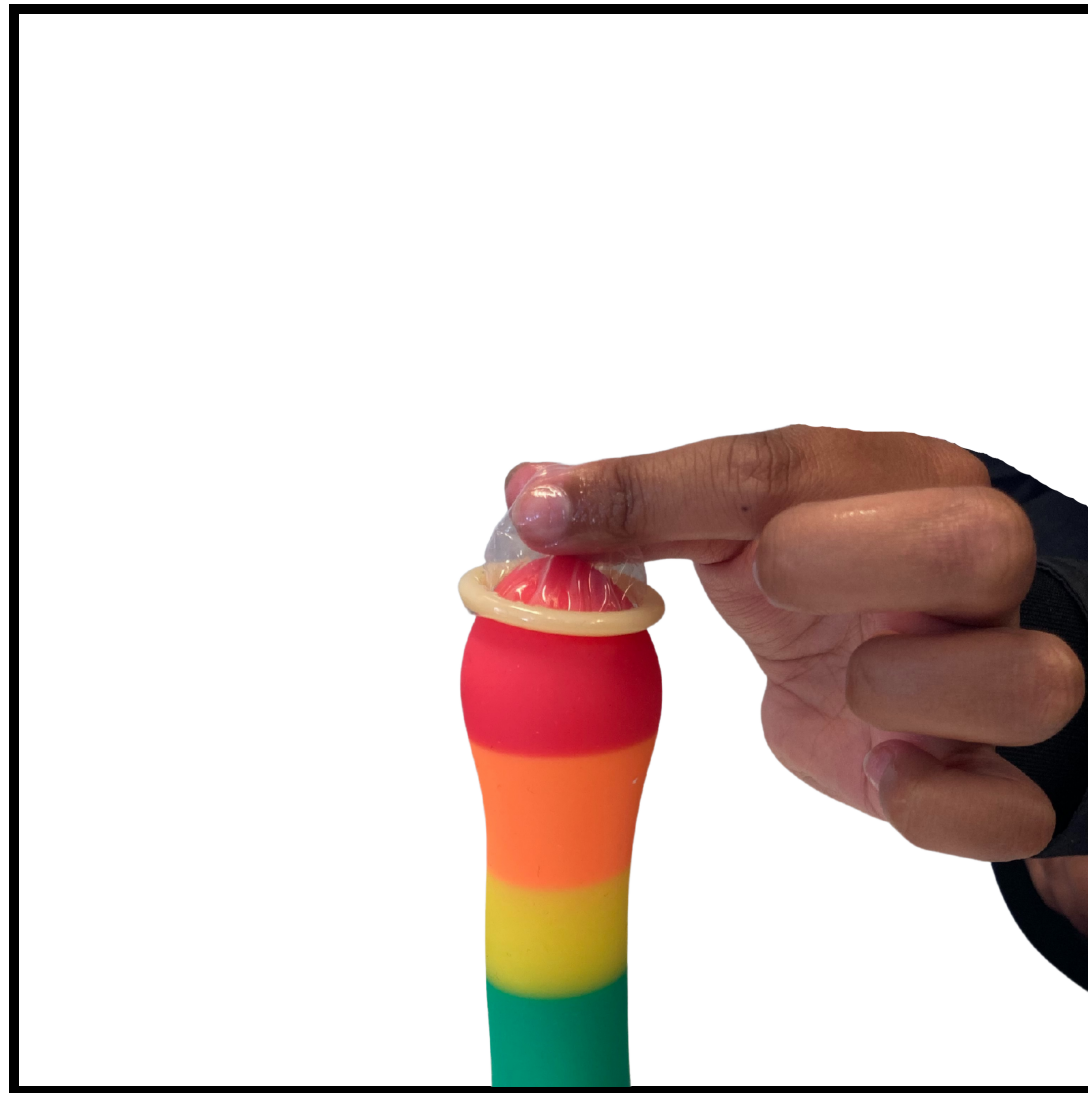


Check the condom is the right way up
(your finger will be able to pull the condom down).

TIP: Use water based lube
before or after putting on
the condom to increase
pleasure!

How to use a condom

STEP 5



With one hand, pinch the top of the condom
(to allow room for ejaculate)
and place on the top of the penis/sex toy.

How to use a condom

STEP 6



With the other hand, roll the condom
all the way down to the base of the penis.

Have sex.

How to use a condom

STEP 7



After ejaculation or after you're finished with penetration, before the penis goes soft, roll the condom off. Make sure any ejaculate stays inside the condom.

How to use a condom

STEP 8



Tie a knot in the condom so that any ejaculate remains inside the condom.
Throw the used condom in the bin.
