



CHANGES THAT MAY OCCUR ON TESTOSTERONE THERAPY

The Effects of Hormone Replacement Therapy for Trans and Gender Diverse People

PHYSICAL

- Rougher, oilier skin, sometimes acne
- Increased sweating
- · Change in smell of sweat and urine
- Growth of the clitoris
- · Body fat redistribution: smaller hips and thighs
- Angular appearance of facial features
- Increased muscle mass
- Increased appetite
- Deepening of the voice
- Periods stop or lighten
- Increased body hair and facial hair
- Male pattern baldness






SEXUAL

- Increased sex drive
- Erection of the clitoris when aroused
- · Sexual pleasure experienced mainly in genitals
- · Orgasms shorter but more intense
- Vaginal dryness
- Thinning of the vaginal walls

EMOTIONAL

- Narrower range of emotions
- More difficult to cry
- Mood swings
