




Why should I use a condom?

Condoms are a single-use barrier method that helps prevent sexually transmitted infections (STIs), blood borne viruses (BBVs) and unintended pregnancy.



Condoms can be used during vaginal sex, and sex, and oral sex on a penis.

Condoms can be used with sex toys such as dildos or vibrators.

Condoms help prevent infections such as bacterial vaginosis (BV) or urinary tract infections (UTIs).

Some people use condoms just to be cautious and put them at ease, or for many other reasons!

Note

Condoms are a single use item. Change your condom if:

- You put the condom on a penis the wrong way
- Are having sex with multiple people
- Are inserting the penis / toy into different body parts (vagina/anus/mouth)

You can purchase condoms at supermarkets, pharmacies, convenience stores, or online.

You can get them for free at sexual health clinics and some youth or community centres.
