





The value of peer educators

50% are more likely to trust the s3xual health advice **59%** of people are more likely to listen

When a Peer Educator delivers s#x ed

69% are more likely to ask questions

58% are more likely to discuss their own s3xual health



Experiences with s#x ed and STI testing


31% of people who got tested in 2022 didn't find the service youth-friendly.

37% of participants didn't have a positive and informative s3x ed experience at school

45% of people who got an STI test in 2022 had a negative experience.


