What is the Youth Sector Survey?

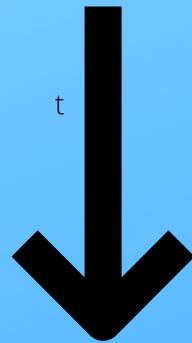
- In late 2021, we invited professionals in the youth sector in WA to participate in an online survey.
- Participants were asked questions regarding their experiences, knowledge and awareness around sexual health and sexual health education in the sector and with their clients.

The majority worked in youth work, mental health and education.



Sector Knowledge

Respondents were keen to **upskill** in several sexual health areas, including:

People with disabilities

Healthy relationships

Body positivity

Transgender and gender diverse young people

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people

Culturally and linguistically diverse young people

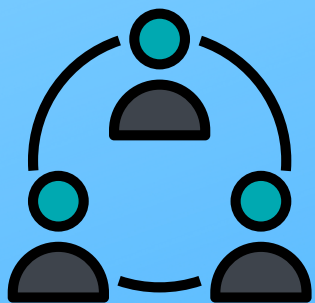


Engagement with YEP

75% of respondents had **interacted with** the **YEP Project** in **2021**.



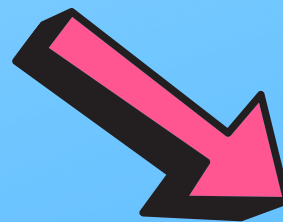
98% of those who had engaged with **online content** from the YEP Project are **satisfied** with the content available.



100% of respondents reported the **YEP project** has **created** online and offline **opportunities** of the health and youth sectors to **connect** over the past two years.

Support for Peer Education and Sexual Health Education

83% of respondents believe that sexual health **behaviours** are more likely to **change** when content is delivered by **peer educators**... Rather than being delivered only by health professionals.



96% of people think their organisation and/or young clients would benefit from a sexual health education program.
