



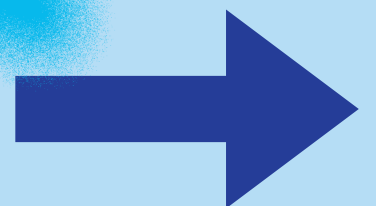

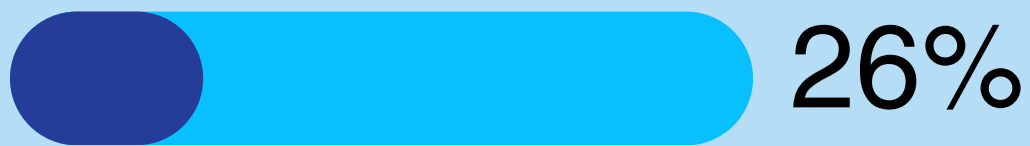

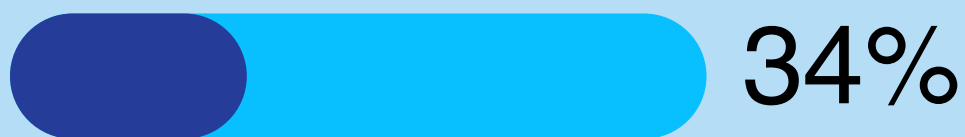

# STI/BBV Testing

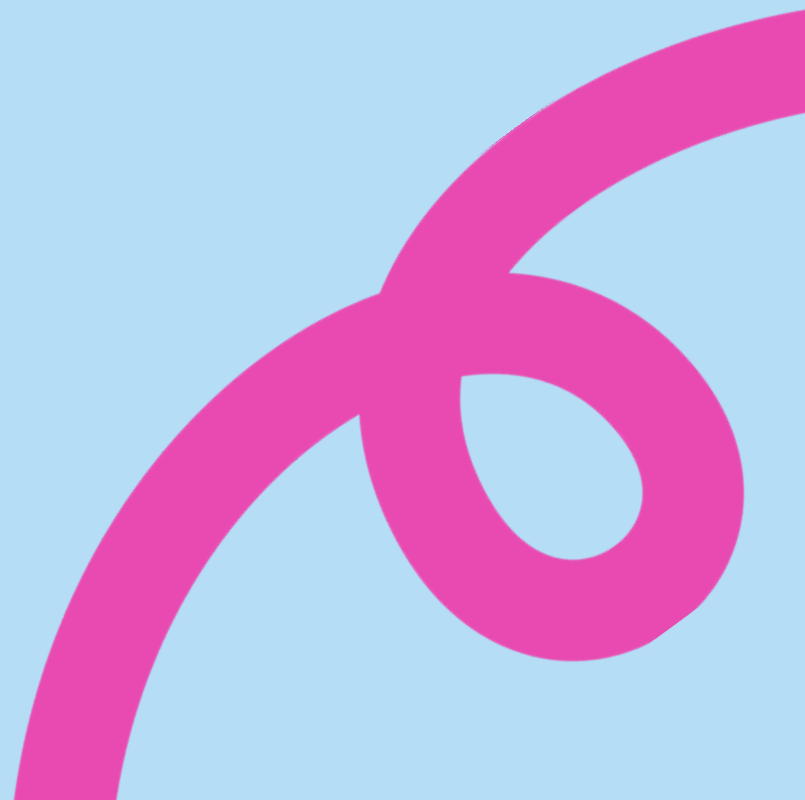
We asked participants if they have had a Sexually Transmitted Infection (**STI**) or Blood-Borne Virus (**BBV**) **check/test** ever:

Have **not** had an STI and a BBV test but **have** had sex



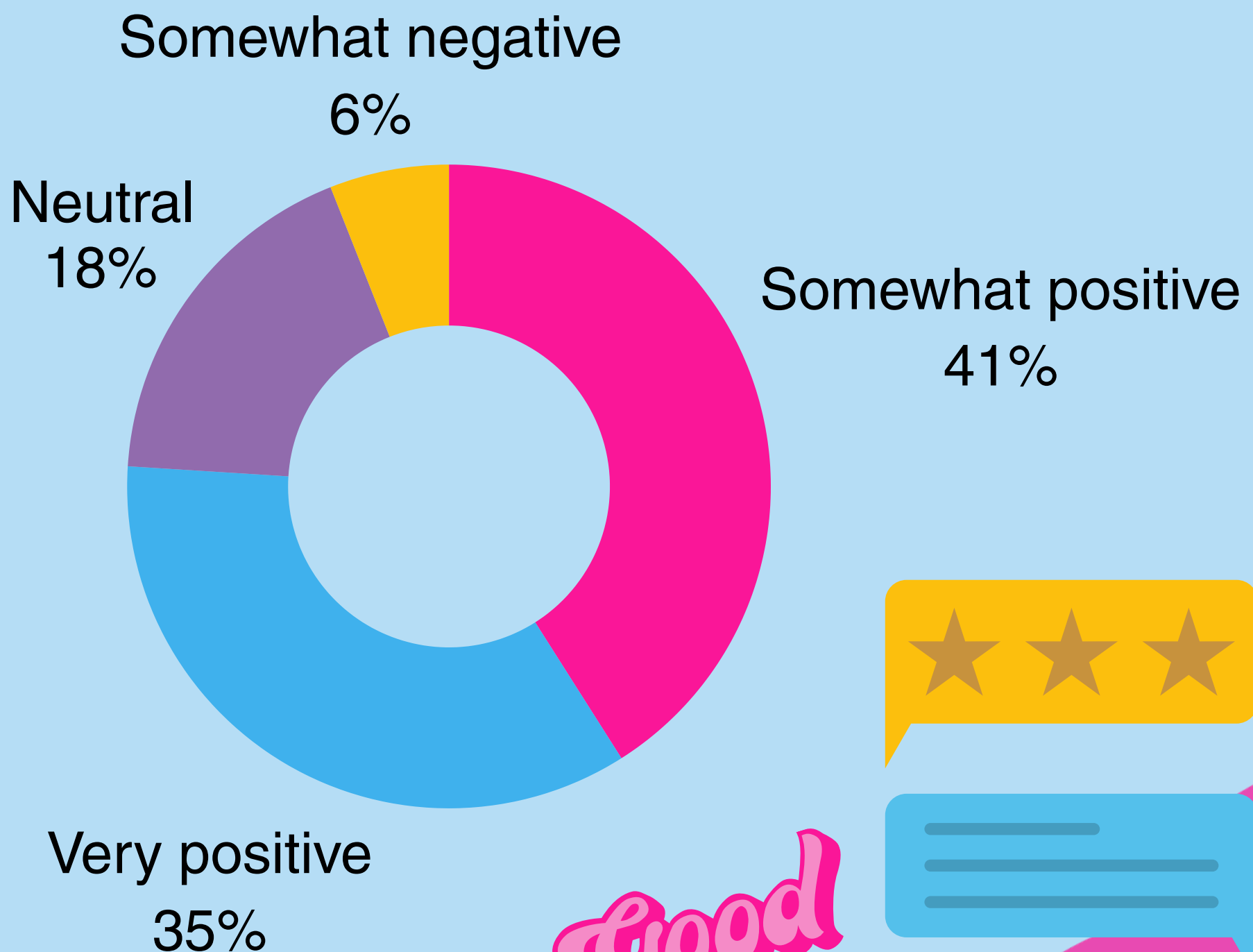

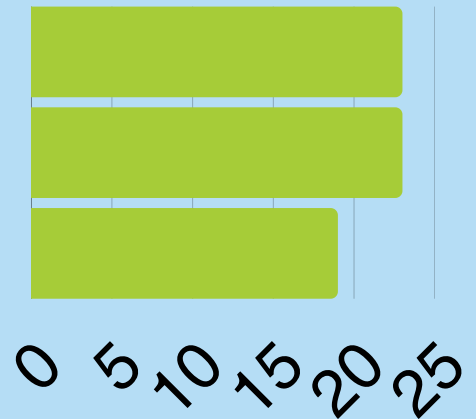


# Motivation

- A youth worker

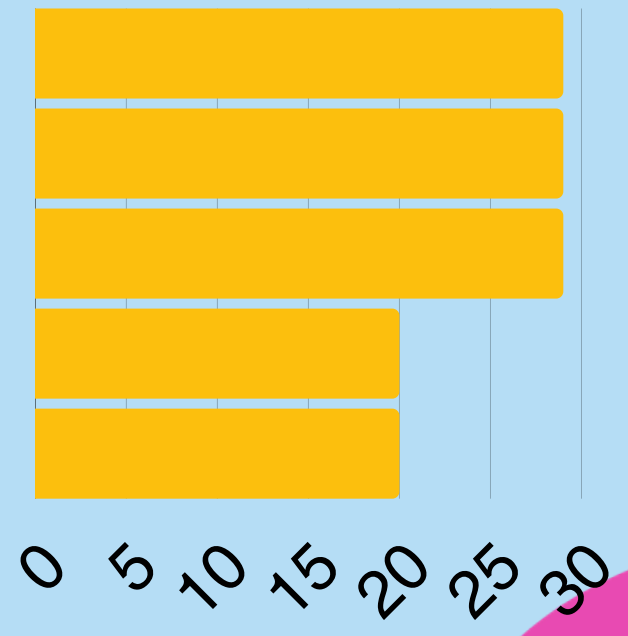


# Hesitation

We asked participants those that ever **felt hesitant/avoided** getting a test what the reasons are/were:



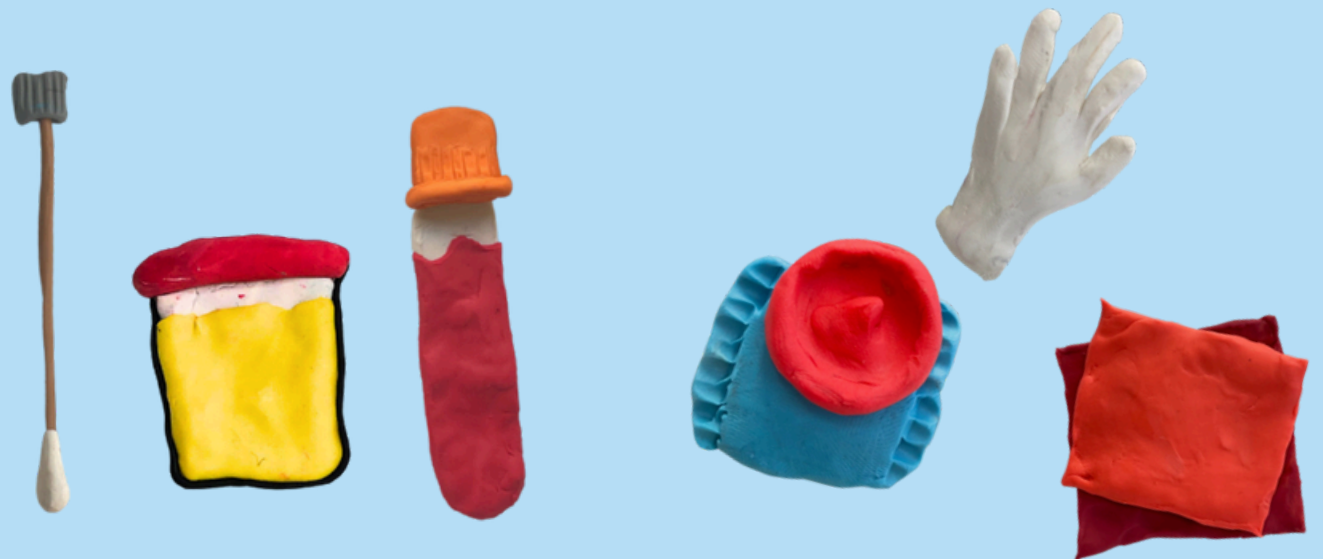
- I don't think I'm at risk
