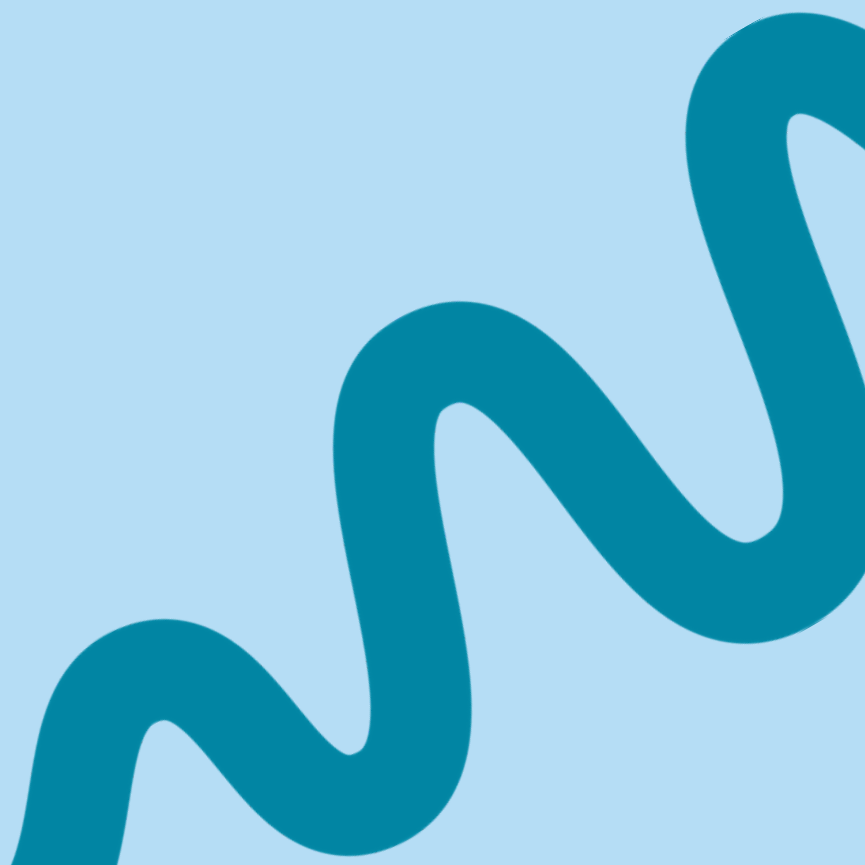

Survey participants told us about their **sexual behaviors**:



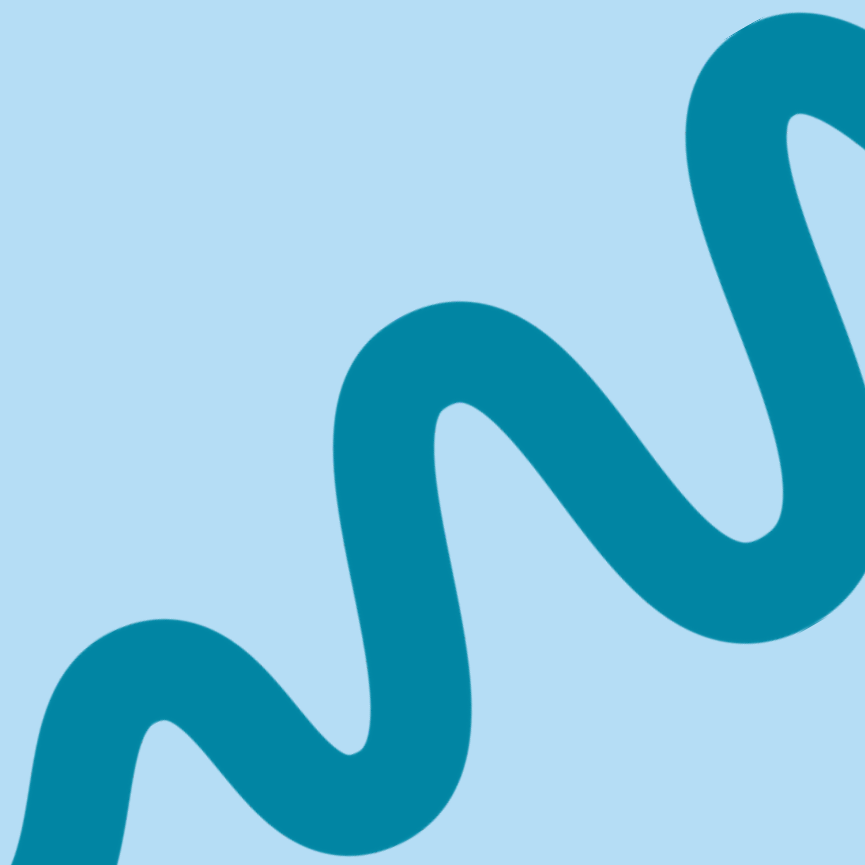
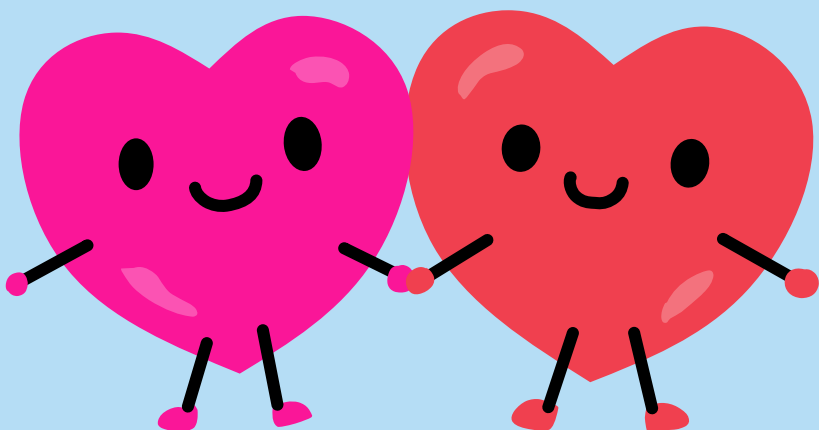
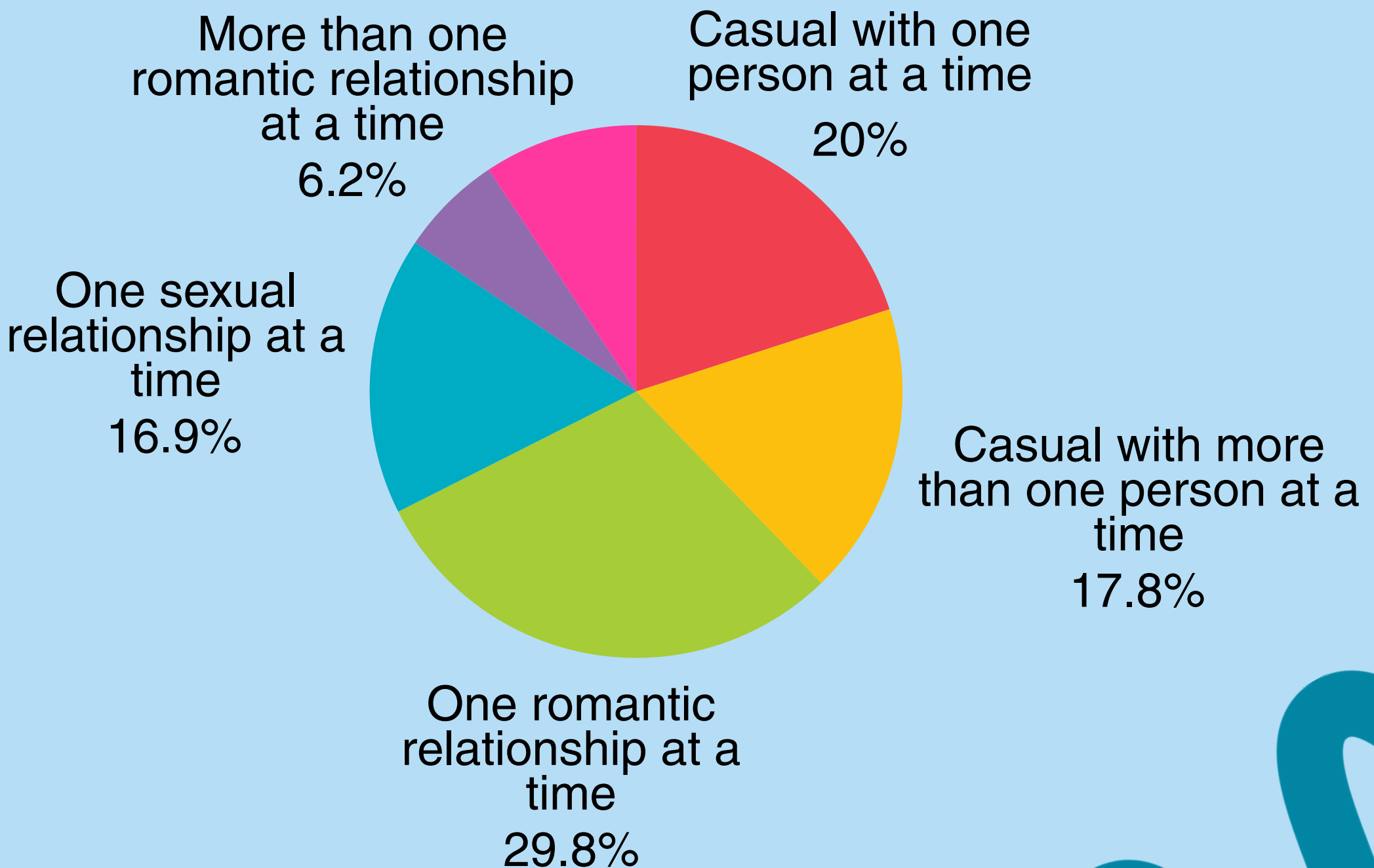

Youth-Friendly Sexual Health & BBV Services on Wadjuk Noongar Boodja / Perth
(December 2025)

All services listed here are located in the Perth metropolitan and Peel areas, are youth-friendly and offer services for Sexual Health and Blood Borne Virus (SHBBV) issues. Use the key on the left side of the page to identify which organisations can offer the kind of support you are looking for.

Southern Services

- Fremantle Women's Health Centre** (Level 1, 108-130 Archibald Street, Willeage, 08 9421 0200) - 16+ yrs old. PHMC is a not-for-profit, community health organisation dedicated to women-centred care. They provide sexual health services, counselling and group activities. PHMC provides medical termination up to 9 weeks.
- Headspace Mandurah** (91 Albany St, Mandurah, 08 95443900) - 12-25 yrs old. Headspace Mandurah is a free and confidential service that helps young people aged 12-25 with health and wellbeing. Their sexual health service is available Wednesday 2-4:30pm for appointments or drop-ins.
- Headspace Rockingham** (37-38 Goddard St, Rockingham, 08 9393 8888) - 12-25 yrs old. Headspace Rockingham is a free and confidential early intervention service for young people aged 12-25. Their sexual health service is available Tuesday 1:30-4:30pm for appointments or drop-ins.
- Yuhar Multicultural Women's Health Services Cannington** (31 Manning Rd, Cannington, 08 9320 8758) - 14+ yrs old women from refugee and migrant backgrounds. Yuhar offers services including women's health, FDI, youth services, mental health, community and professional education, advocacy and social support. Yuhar welcomes anyone who identifies as a woman, anyone who was assigned female at birth and women of any sexual orientation.

Northern Services

- Nidjala Waangan Mia** (112 Lakes Road, Mandurah East, 08 9581 4280) - All ages. Nidjala Waangan Mia offers health and wellbeing services for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. The team includes Aboriginal health workers, sexual health nurses and Aboriginal youth workers.
- Peel Youth Medical Service** (94 Albany St, Mandurah, 08 9583 3433) - 12-25 yrs old. Peel Youth Medical Service is a doctor and nurse service for young people aged 12-25 including general health and STI checks.
- South Coastal Health & Community Services** (4 Civic Blvd, Rockingham, 08 9350 0900) - 11+ yrs old. South Coastal Health and Community Services was founded to support the physical and mental needs of women and families. They provide counselling, therapeutic & support group, general health services and Aboriginal health and wellbeing services.
- South Terrace Clinic Fremantle Hospital** (South Terrace Clinic, A Block, Fremantle Hospital, 08 9421 2149) - 13+ yrs old. A sexual health clinic that provides free testing and treatment for STIs, including PEP and PrEP.
- Perth Men's Health Murdoch** (3 Barry Marshall Parade, Murdoch, 08 9389 3400) - 16+ yrs old. Perth Men's Health aims to improve both sexual health and overall health through the prevention, early diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of conditions or diseases that involve sexual function.
- Deerwah Yerrigan Health Service Mirrabooka** (22 Chesterfield Rd, Mirrabooka, 1800 311 888) - All ages. Deerwah Yerrigan Health services provides holistic primary care services to Aboriginal people living or visiting Wadjuk. Noongar Broods Clinics are open Monday to Friday. *Specialist and allied health services vary between sites.
- Yuhar Multicultural Women's Health Services Mirrabooka** (23 Sudbury Rd, Mirrabooka, 08 9342 5233) - 14+ yrs old women from refugee and migrant backgrounds. Yuhar offers a variety of services including women's health, family and domestic violence, youth services, mental health, community and professional education, advocacy and social support. Yuhar is a LGBTQI+ friendly service and welcomes women of any sexual orientation, anyone who identifies as a woman and anyone who was assigned female identity at birth.
- Sexual Health North** (375 Regent's Park Road, Joondalup, 08 9429 9340) - 16+ yrs old (sexual health services) 18+ yrs old (gender services). Sexual Health North offer testing and treatment for STIs and BBVs and other sexual health conditions. They also provide gender affirming hormone therapies. *PEP available under certain circumstances.

Mobile Services

- Black Swan Health Free Street Doctor** (Various locations in Fremantle, 08 9422 0482) - All ages. A mobile, medical health service that provides an easily accessible, non-judgmental primary health service for people who are marginalised or disadvantaged in the community.
- Street Doctor** (Various locations in Perth metro, 08 9376 9300) - All ages. A mobile GP clinic providing services to youth, homeless, discouraged and Aboriginal clients who have found barriers accessing health care through traditional methods.
- Luma Joondalup** (670 Davidson Terrace Joondalup, 08 9330 3400) - All ages* depending on program. Luma Joondalup is a mobile GP clinic providing services to youth, homeless, discouraged and Aboriginal clients who have found barriers accessing health care through traditional methods.
- Perth Men's Health Neelands** (27195 Neelands Avenue, Neelands, 08 9389 3400) - 16+ yrs old. Perth Men's Health aims to improve both sexual health and overall health through the prevention, early diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of conditions or diseases that involve sexual function.
