





What best describes your area of work?




Relevance of Sexual Health





How relevant are sexual health matters to your work and your client group?




Organisational Culture





Do you feel that your organisational culture (e.g. management support, staff attitudes) is one that encourages staff to engage and education young people on matters related to sexual health?




Top 10 Sector Information Sources





Over the past two years, what support or information sources have you found most useful in supporting your work to enhance the sexual wellbeing young people?





Over the NEXT two years is your organisation planning on developing any of the following in relation to youth sexual health?



Qualitative responses included:


- "Ensure current resources are diverse and inclusive (specifically supporting gender diversity and sexuality)"

In the last two years have you referred young people for STI and/or BBV testing or related support?




 60.82% of participants had referred young people to sexual health services

Ease of Youth STI Testing






In your opinion, how easy is it for your young clients to access confidential STI & BBV treatment and testing?



Top 10 Perceived Barriers to Youth Sexual Health






- Several participants noted a lack of accessibility to sexual health services in regional and remote areas

Do you think your behaviours around youth sexual health are more or less likely to change, with having the content delivered by youth peer educators?




Benefits of Sexual Health Programs





Do you think your organisation and/or young clients would benefit from a sexual health education program (formal or informal)?




Sector Connection





In the last two years the YEP project has created online and offline opportunities of the health and youth sectors to connect.




Collaboration with Sexual Health Services





In the last two years have you noticed an increase in your collaboration or engagement with sexual health services?




Top 10 Topics for Future Professional Development





In relation to youth sexual health, please rank what would you like future support or professional development on?



Top 10 Topics for Future Professional Development





Participants were given the opportunity to comment.

- Many participants noted a desire for more regional and remote professional development
- "More support around communicating and language in school settings with young people who identify
 as a young person from the LGBTQIA+ community. Would also like to see more research around the
 impacts of 'labelling' gender and sexuality in young people"
- "Ways of working with individuals who have disabilities (physical and intellectual)"
- "Supporting YP in the LGBTIQ community & when YP are questioning their gender or sexuality"
- "Need more healthy relationship workshops for youth"
