



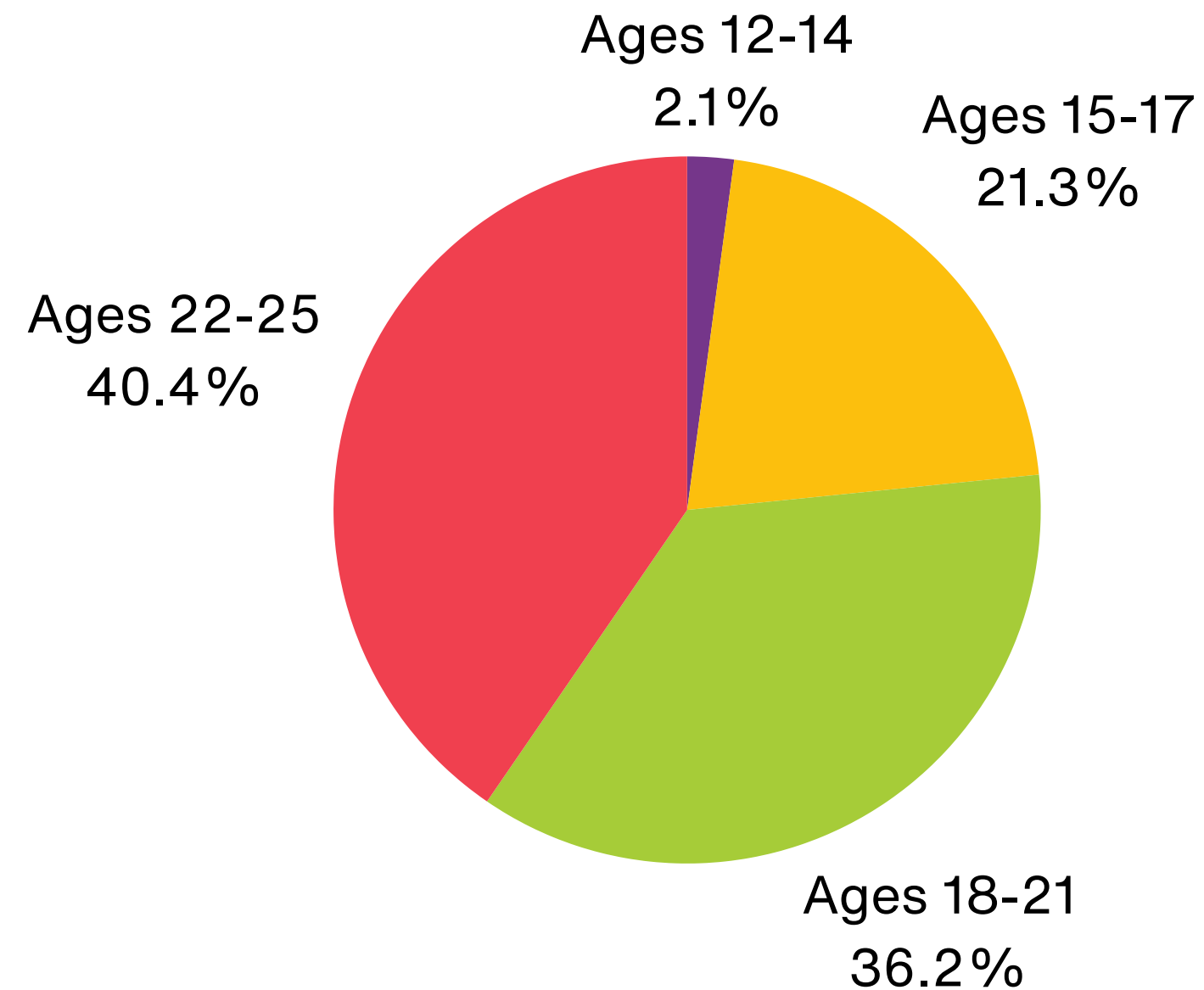

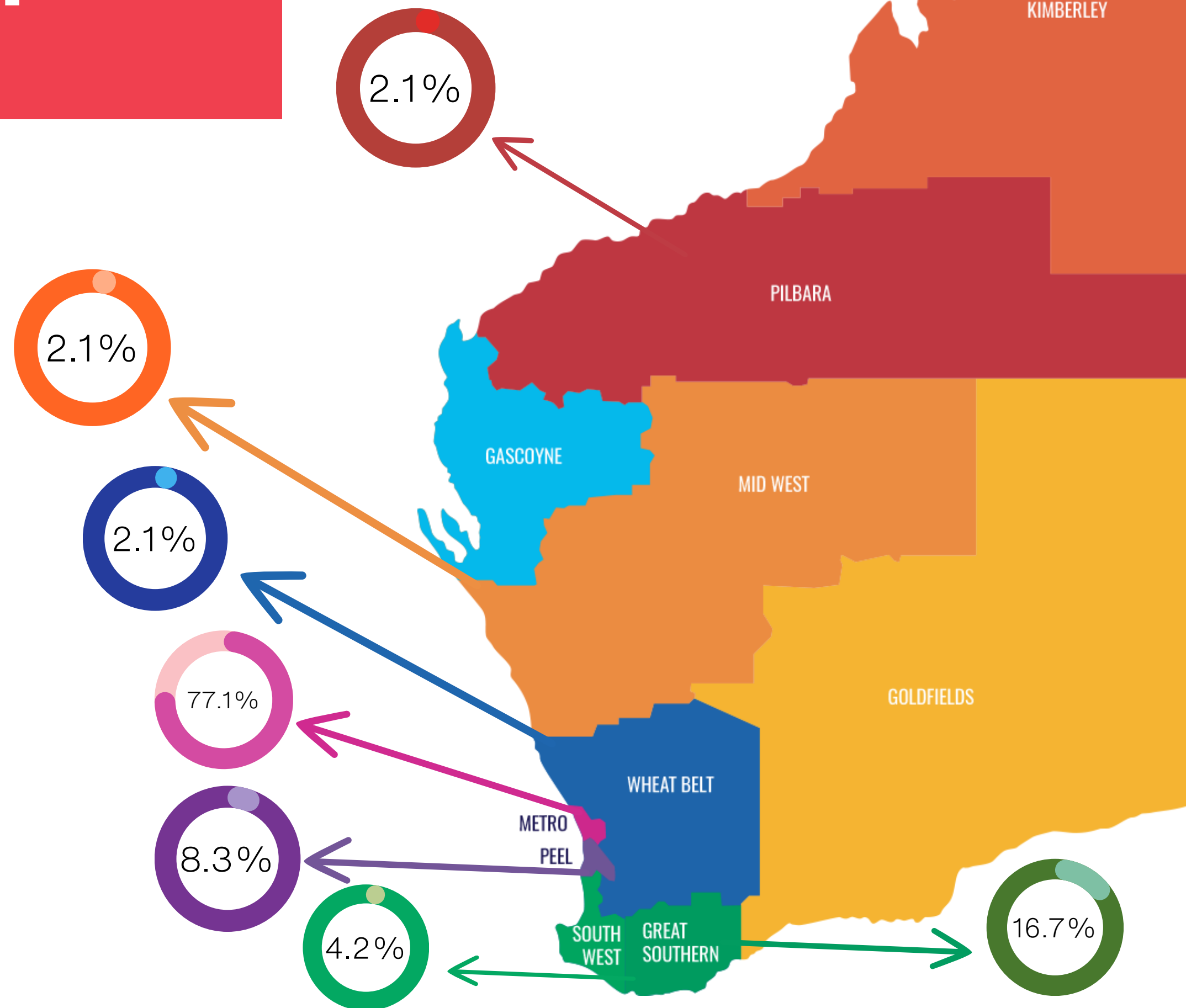

Of **55** participants in the survey, most were **22-25** years and **18-21** years old.

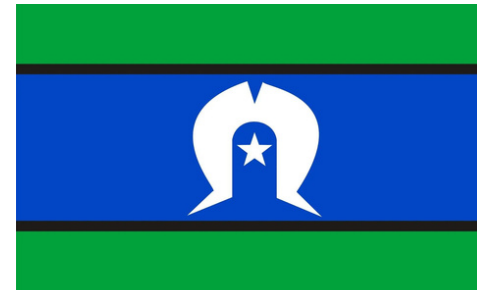


Regions Participants Reside In

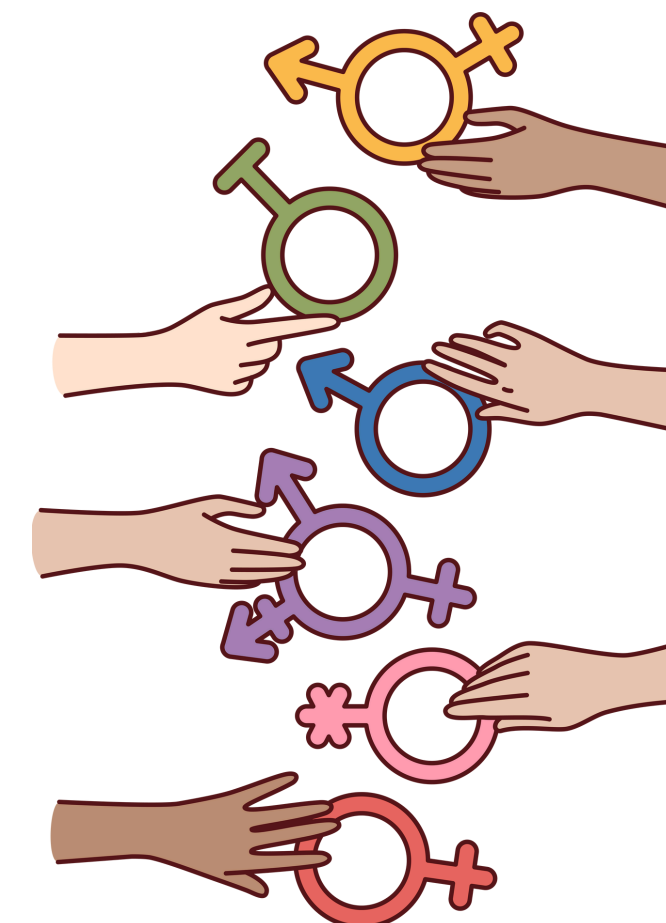
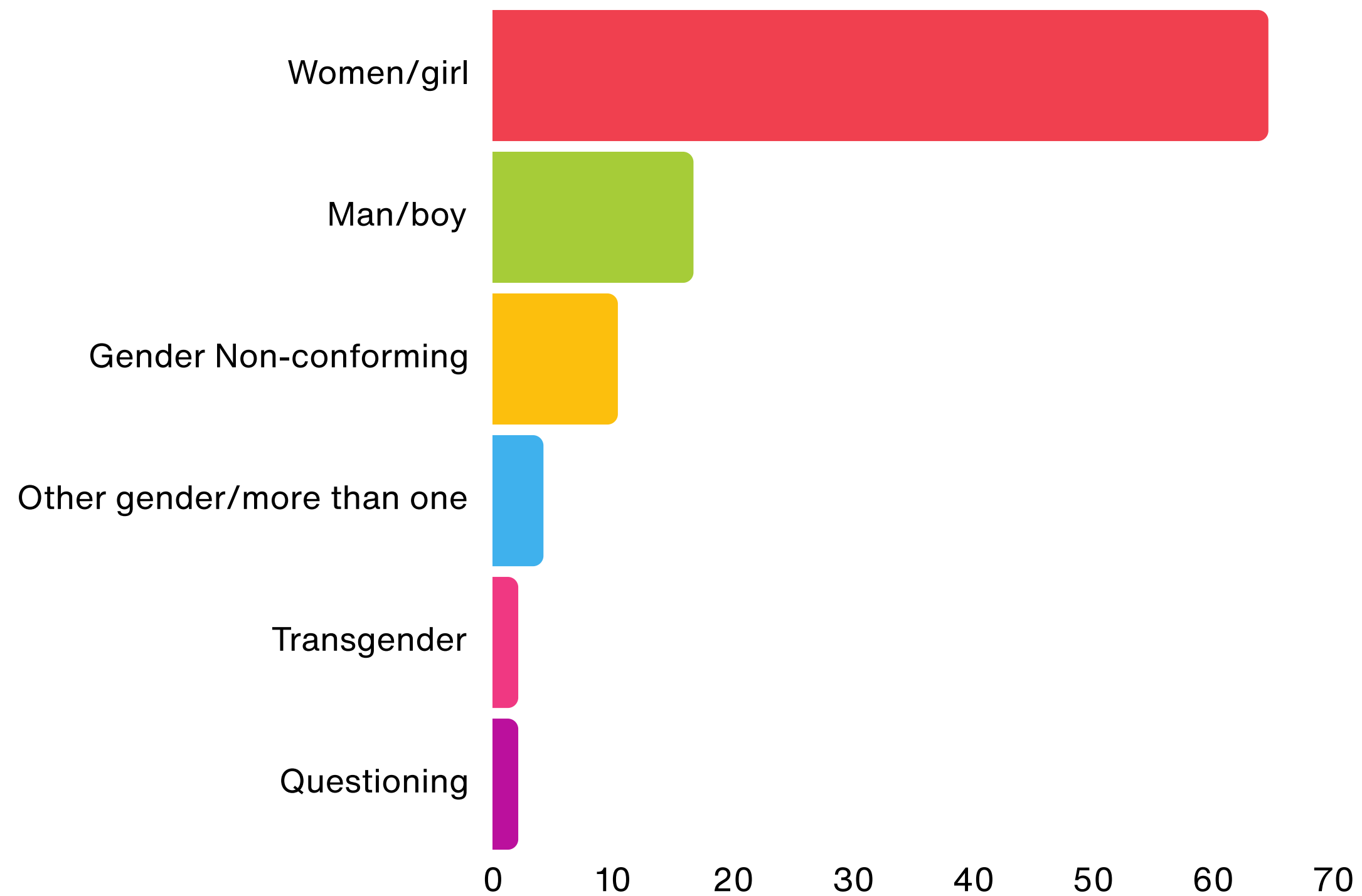


Intersectional Backgrounds

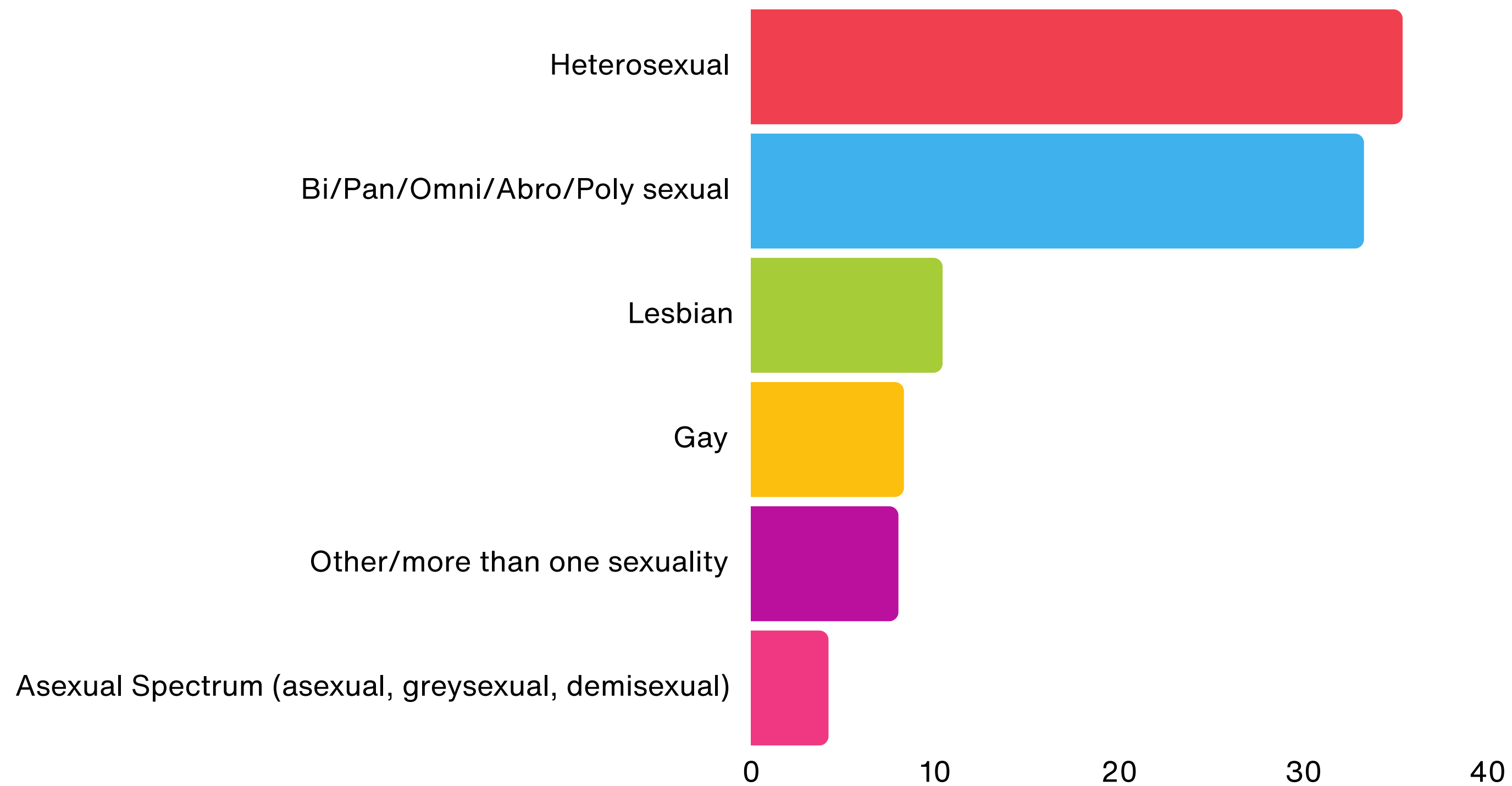
- **4.2%** of responders identified as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander

- **14.6%** of respondents identify as trans or gender diverse



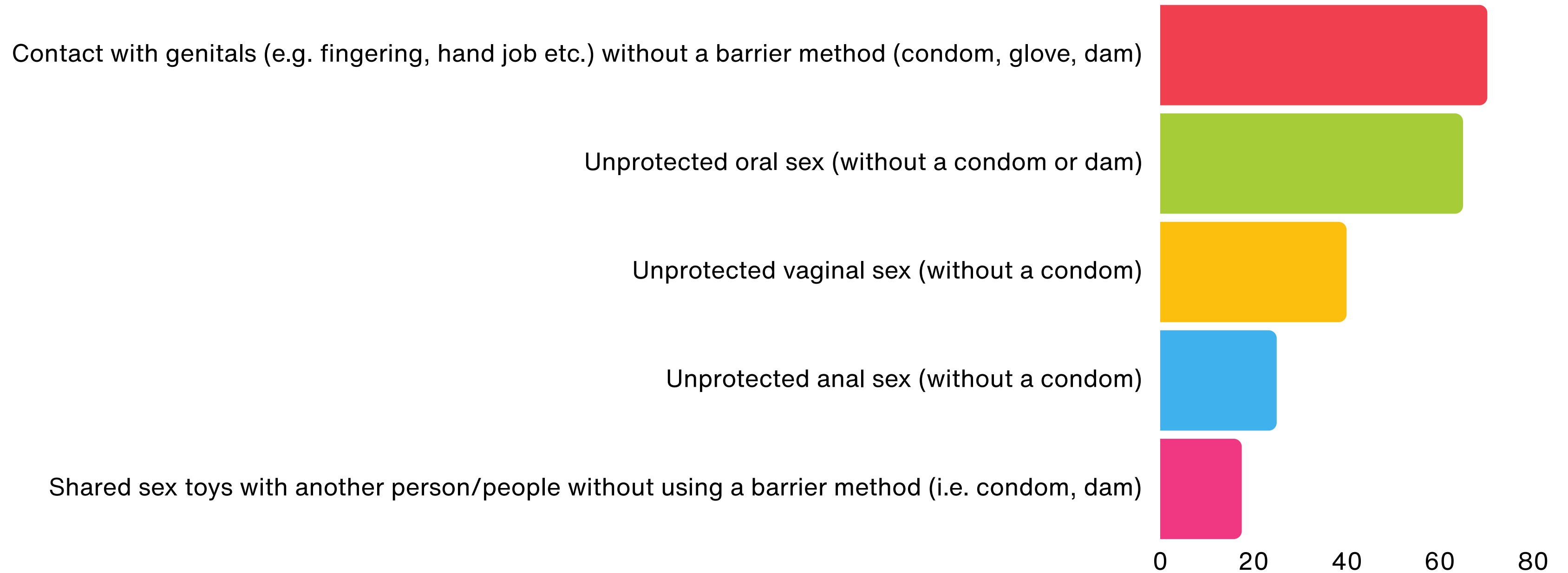
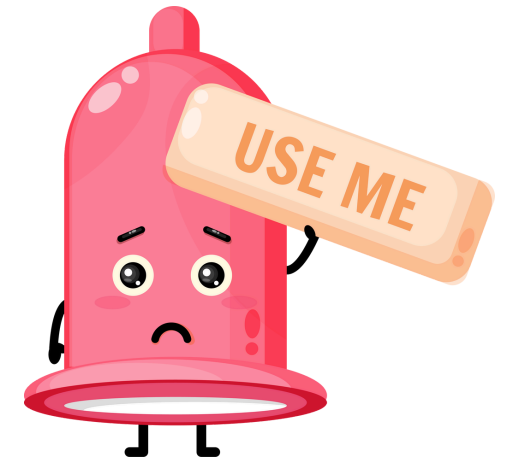

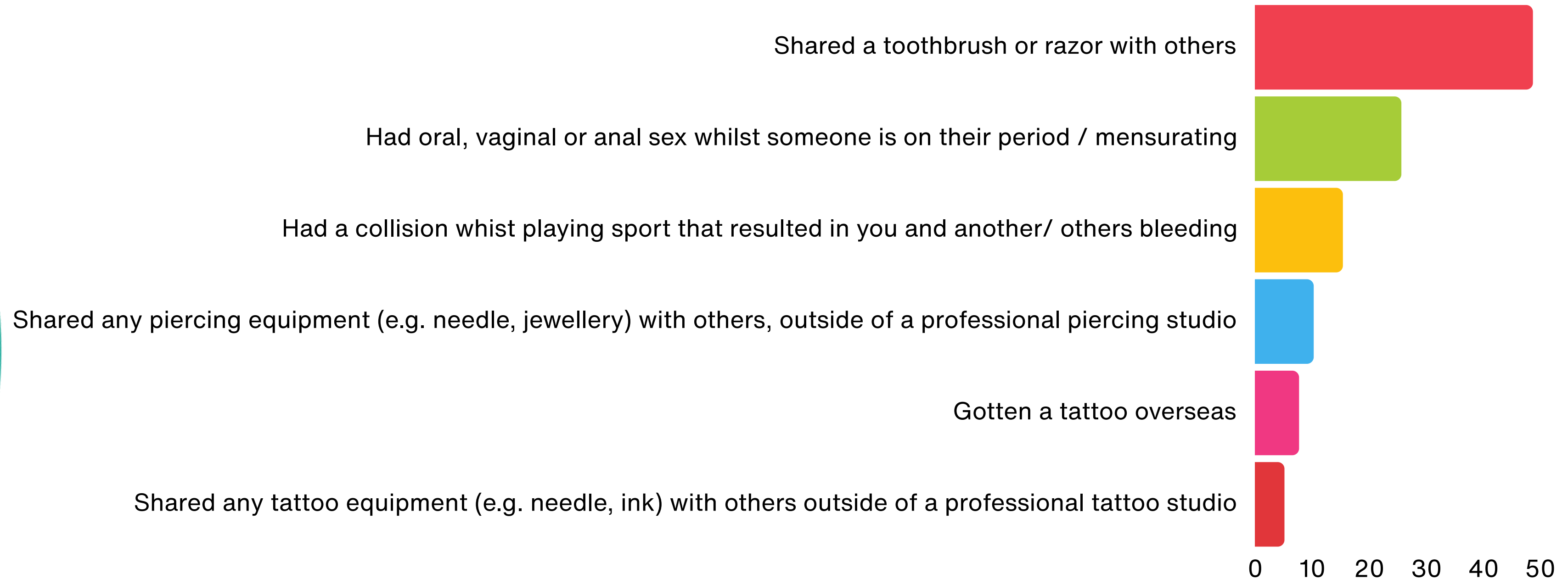

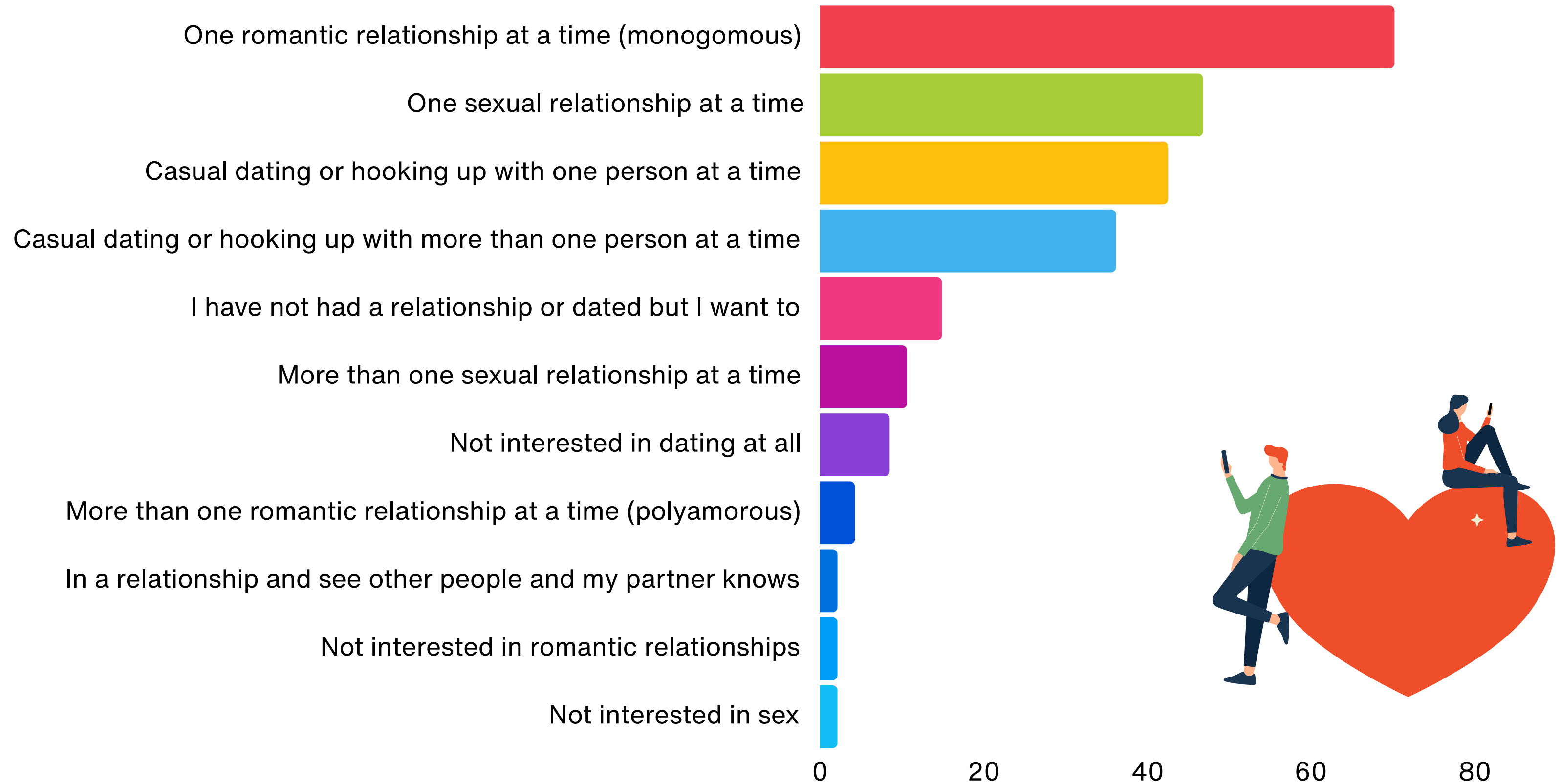

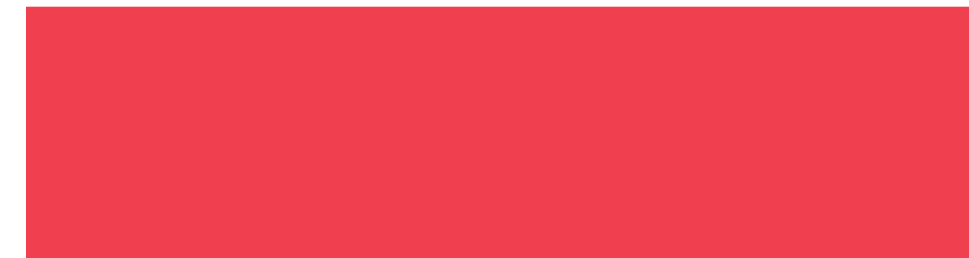


The Power of Peers

Your parent or guardian

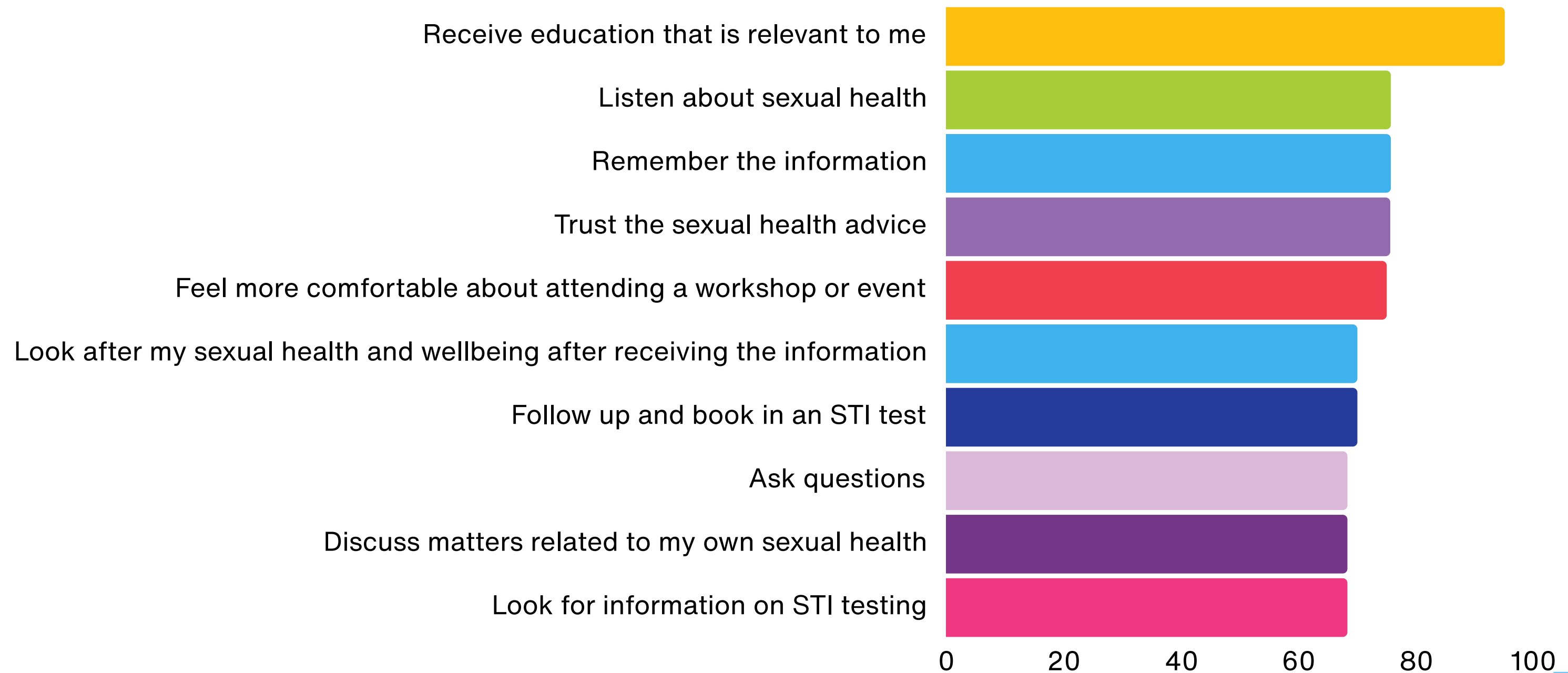

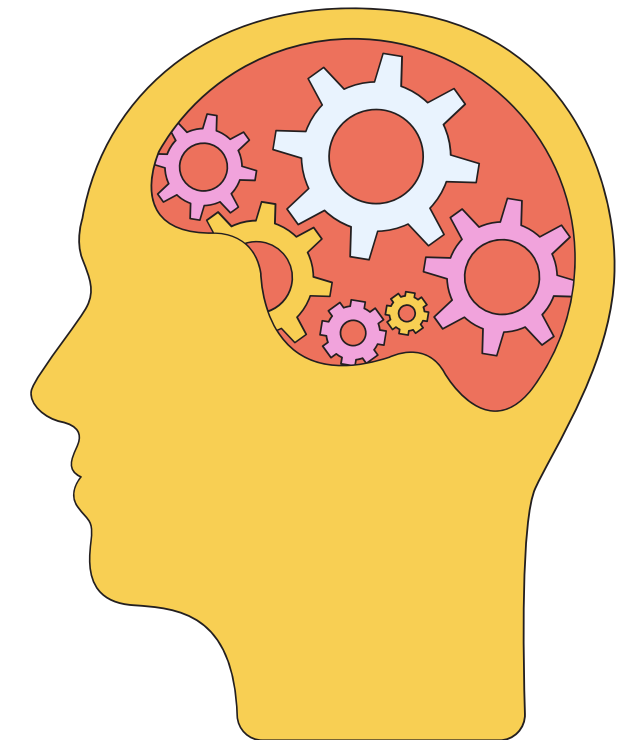
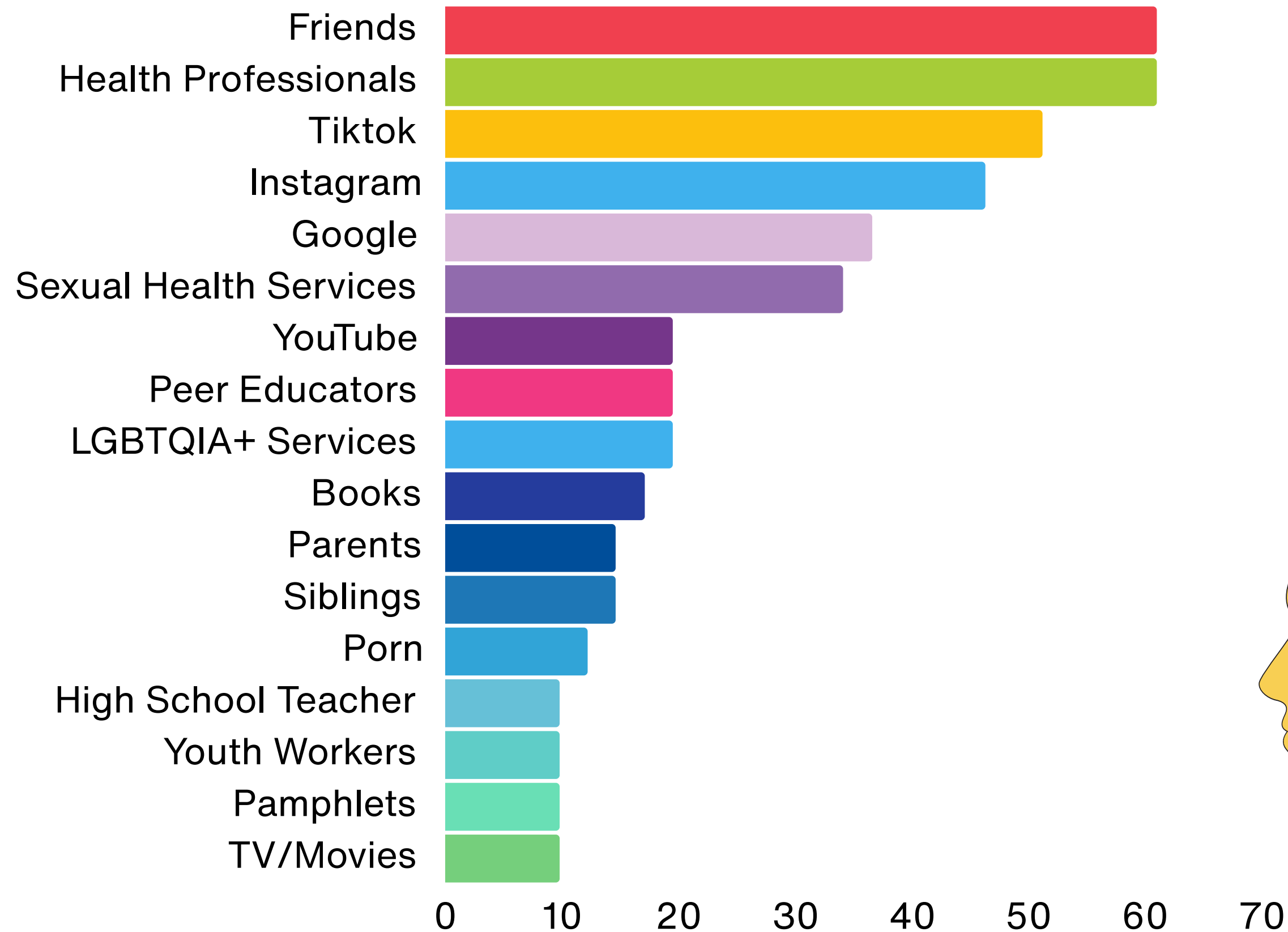

Responses to receiving sexual health information from a **qualified young person** over an adult

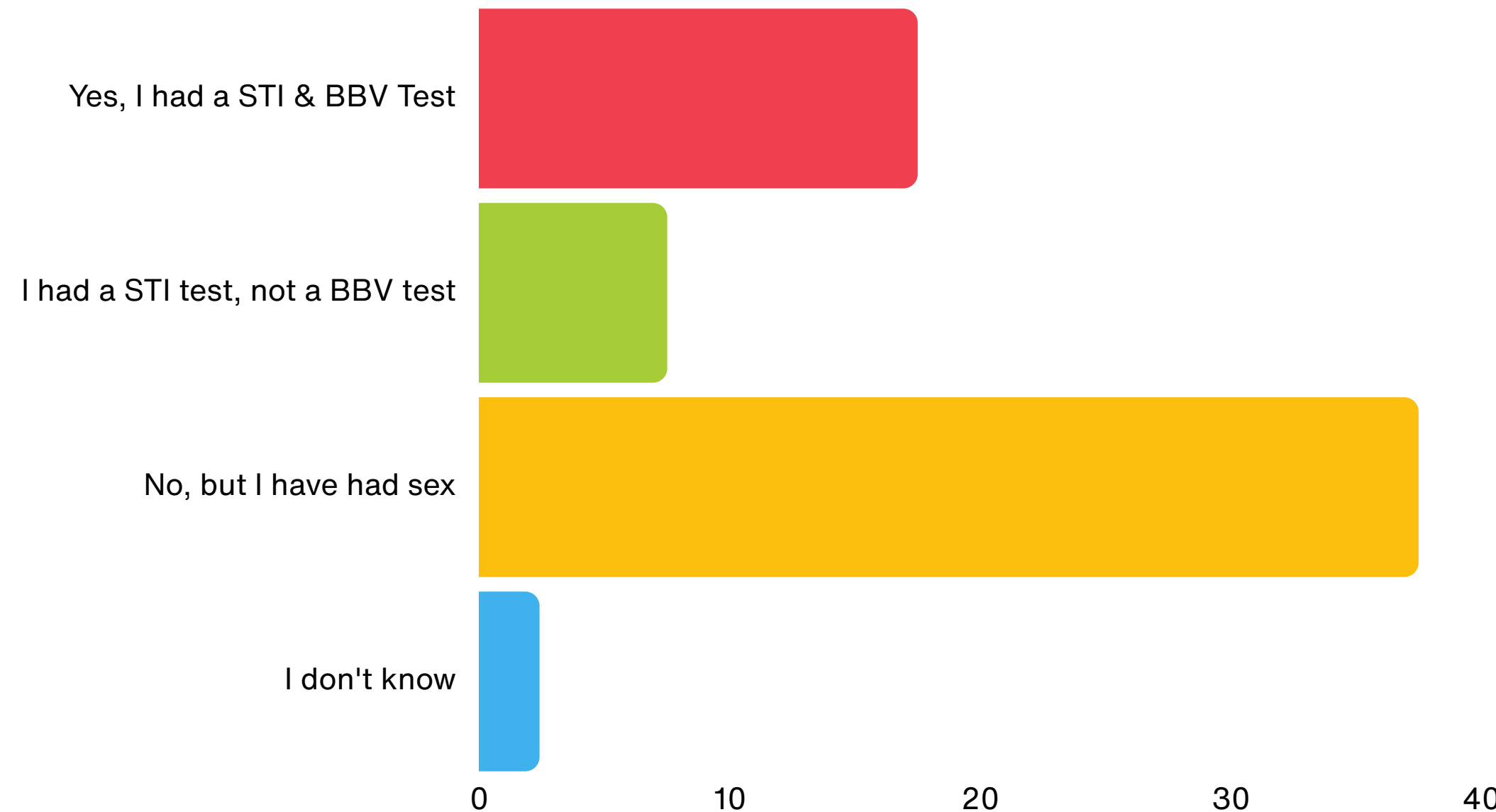

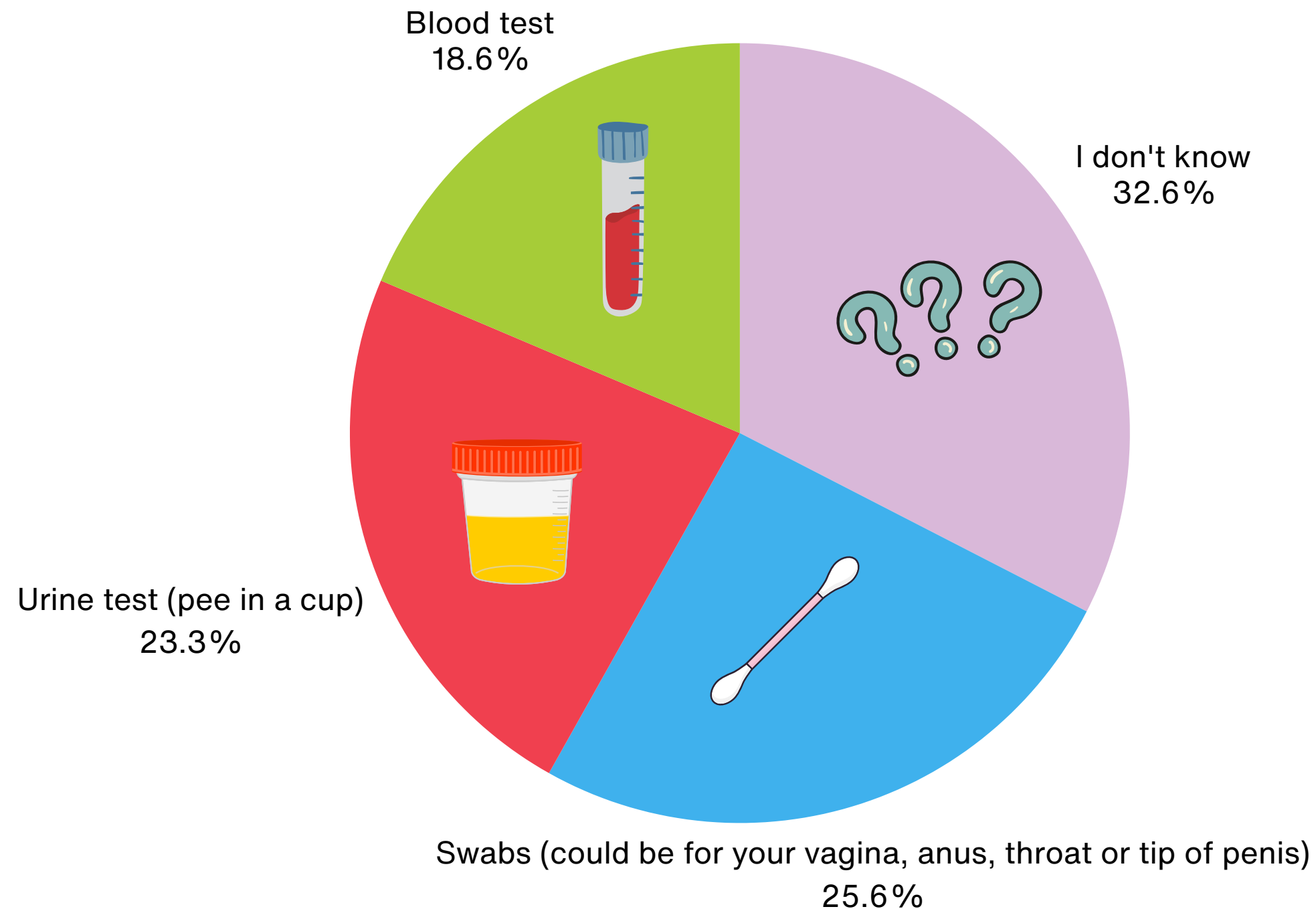

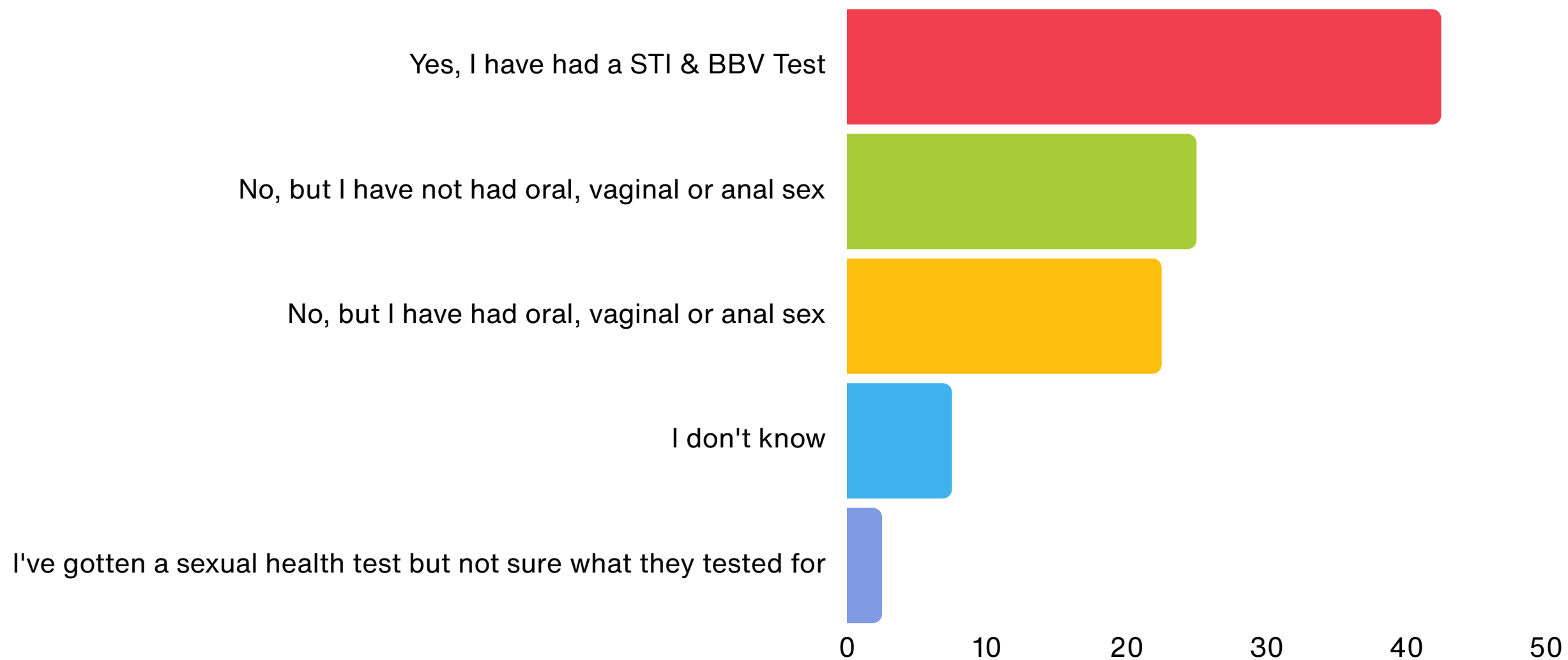

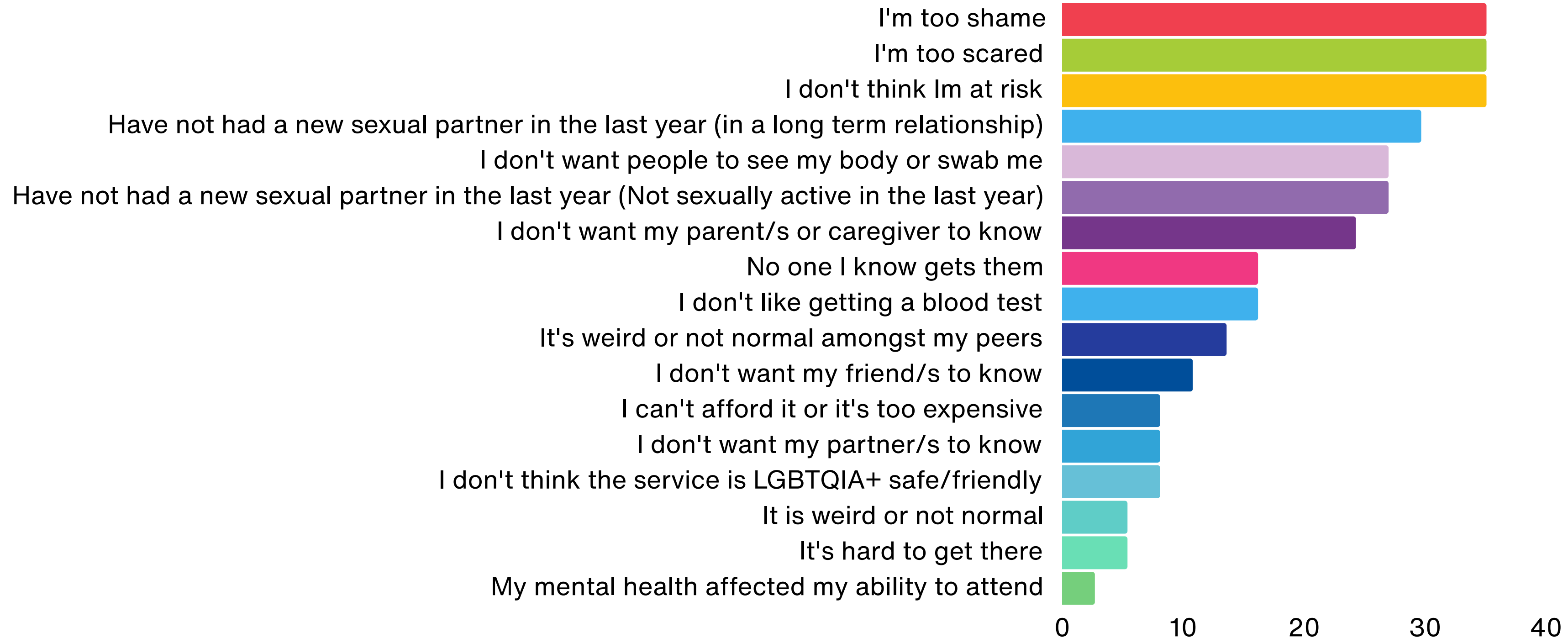

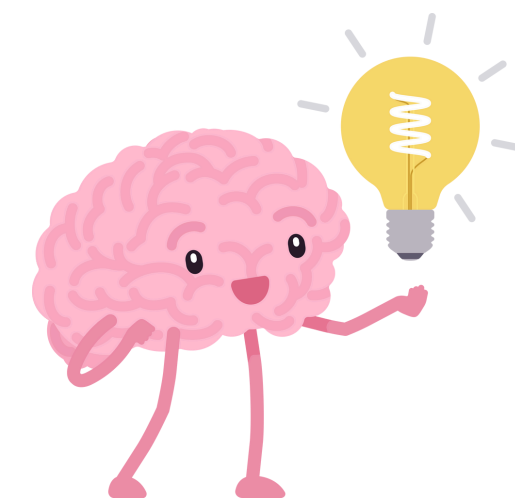

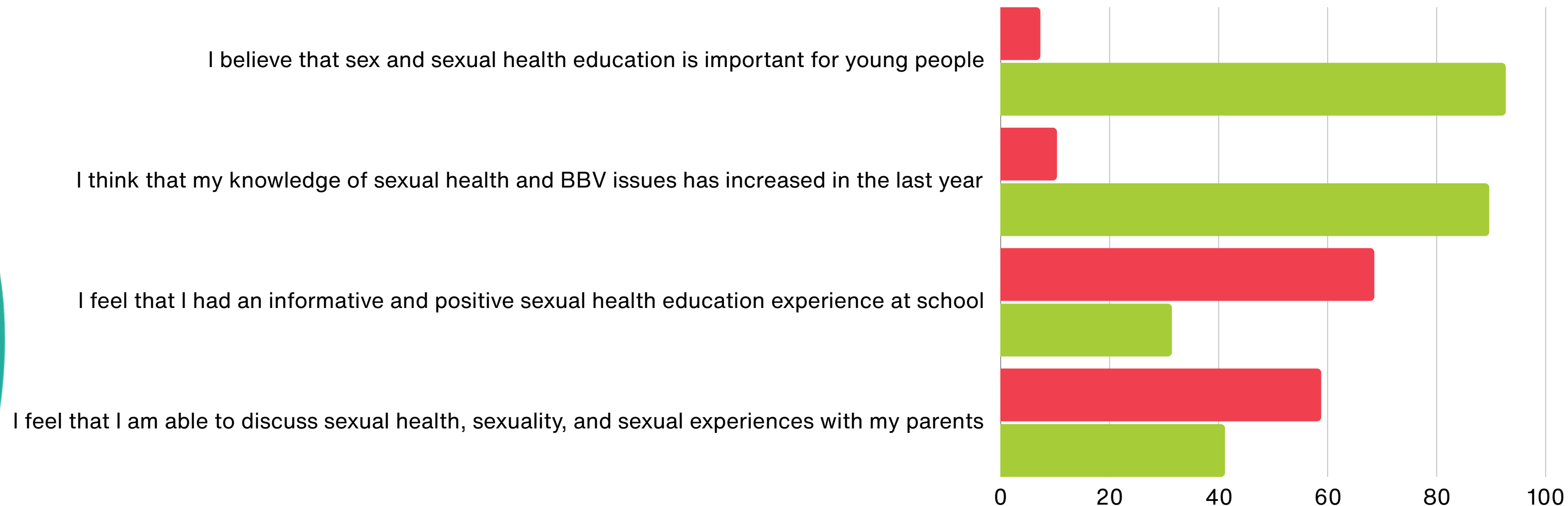

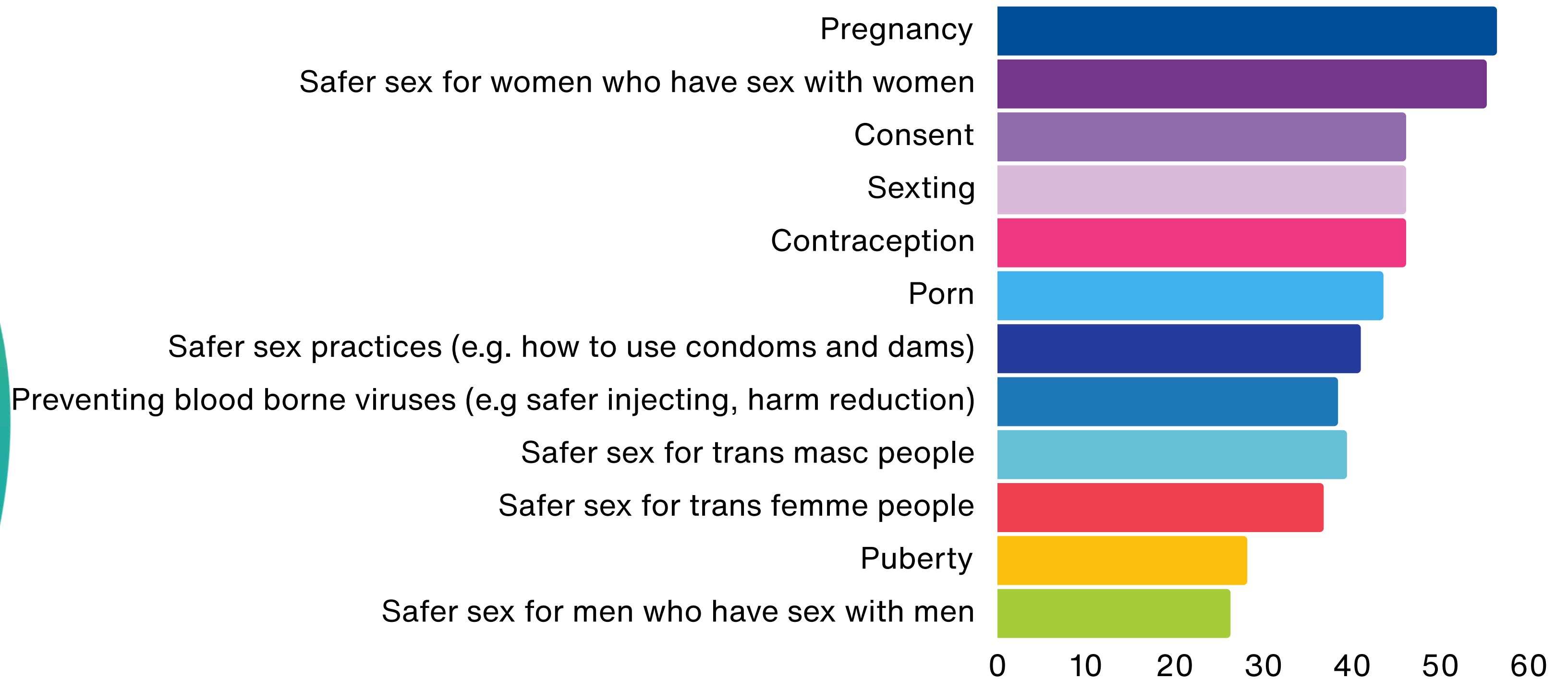
