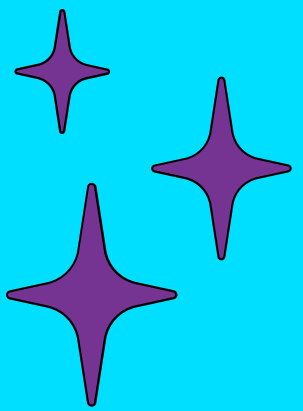
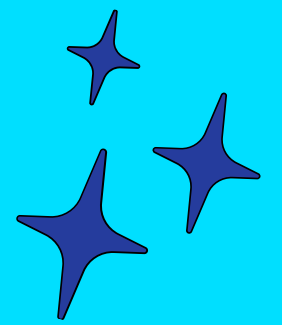
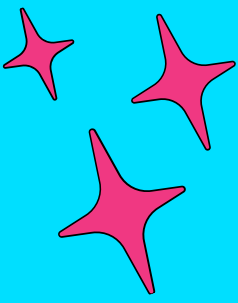

YEP's Message for Sexual Health Week

- There's no shame in getting STI and BBV tests - it's the best way to know if you have any STI/BBV, and the sooner you know, the sooner you can get treated!
- Get STI check done every 3 months if you have multiple partners, or once a year if you're in a committed relationship.
- If you do receive a positive result, you can get support and advice from your doctor or sexual health clinician, and they can support you to tell your sexual partner/s.
- Use barrier methods such as condoms, dental dams and gloves to prevent STIs and BBVs from spreading.
